INTERNAL TRADE DIVISION.

According to returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending March 25th, 1921, the quantity of grain in store at the different Public Elevators throughout Canada has increased by 1,184,198 bushels in wheat; barley, 358,854 bushels; flax, 50,022 bushels and rye, 164,575 bushels. Oats indicates a decrease of 319,078 bushels, as compared with the previous week. Briefly the situation of grain in store is as follows:-

In the Western Country Elevators a decrease is shown in wheat of 542,904 bushels and oats, 1,138,252 bushels. Barley shows an increase of 24,008 bushels and flax, 53 bushels.

In the Interior Terminal Elevators an increase is shown in oats of 177,046 bushels. Wheat indicates a decrease of 11,568 bushels; barley, 2,570 bushels and flax, 1,144 bushels.

In the Public Terminal Elevators at Fort William and Port Arthur an increase is shown in wheat of 262,827 bushels; oats, 790,534 bushels; barley, 262,290 bushels; flax, 51,113 bushels and rye, 22,759 bushels. In the Private Terminal Elevators a decrease is shown in wheat of 188,037 bushels and barley, 5,567 bushels. Oats indicates an increase of 29,534 bushels and rye, 2 bushels.

In the Public Elevators in the East decreases are shown in wheat of 68,198 bushels; oats, 225,173 bushels and barley, 188,472 bushels.

In the United States Atlantic Seaboard Ports increases are shown in wheat of 1,732,078 bushels; oats, 47,233 bushels; barley 269,165 bushels and rye, 141,814 bushels.

The inspections for the week ending March 21st, 1921, show 2,794 cars as compared with 3,399 of the previous week.
