INTERNAL TRADE DIVISION.

According to returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending April 15th, 1921, the quantity of grain in store at the different Public Elevators throughout Canada has decreased by 2,339,294 bushels in wheat; oats, 451,801 bushels; barley, 3,176 bushels and flax, 214,706 bushels. Rye indicates an increase of 5,660 bushels. Briefly the situation of grain in store is as follows:-

In the Western Country Elevators a decrease is shown in wheat of 806,929 bushels; oats, 1,184,447 bushels and flax, 237,005 bushels. Barley indicates an increase of 4,999 bushels.

In the Interior Terminal Elevators a decrease is shown in wheat of 366,644 bushels; oats, 123,134 bushels; barley, 1,271 bushels and rye, 1,254 bushels. Flax indicates an increase of 1,290 bushels.

In the Public Terminal Elevators at Fort William and Port Arthur, wheat indicates a decrease of 1,089,301 bushels while oats shows an increase of 697,941 bushels; barley, 135,855 bushels; flax, 11,184 bushels and rye, 13,113 bushels. In the Private Terminal Elevators a decrease is shown in wheat of 401,423 bushels and rye, 573 bushels. Oats indicates an increase of 99,915 bushels; barley, 1,915 bushels and flax, 9,825 bushels.

In the Public Elevators in the East decreases are shown in wheat of 163,080 bushels; oats, 143,132 bushels and barley, 72,621 bushels.

In the United States Atlantic Seaboard Ports an increase is shown in oats of 205,392 bushels. Wheat indicates a decrease of 34,964 bushels; barley, 70,826 bushels and rye, 5,626 bushels.

In the United States Lake Ports an increase is shown in wheat of 523,047 bushels. Oats indicates a decrease of 4,336 bushels and barley, 1,227 bushels.

The inspections for the week ending April 14th, 1921, show 2,145 cars as compared with 2,482 of the previous week.

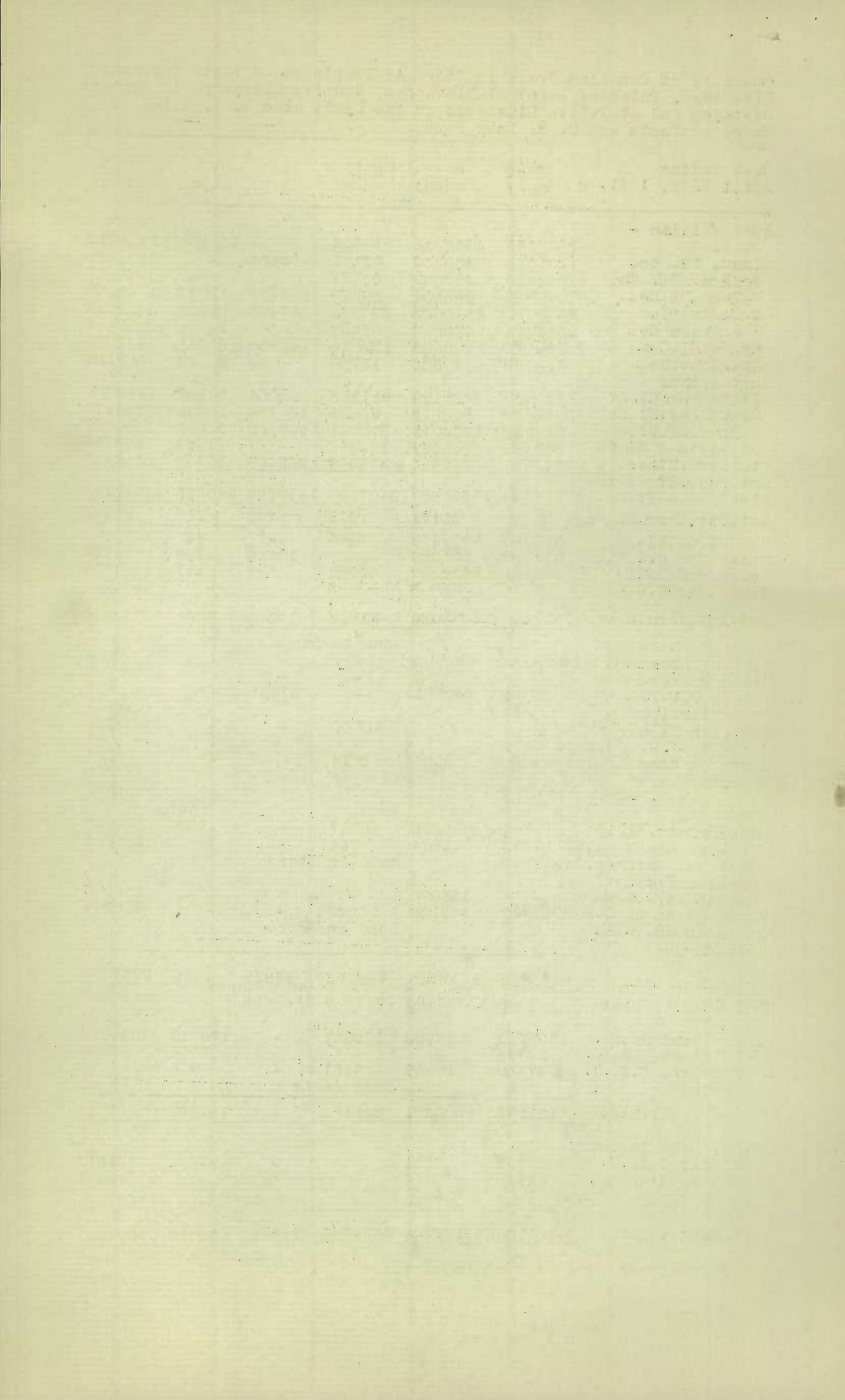
