INTERNAL TRADE DIVISION.

According to returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending May 27th, 1921, the quantity of grain in store at the different Public Elevators throughout Canada has decreased by 1,694,106 bushels in wheat; oats, 509,336 bushels; and barley, 405,166 bushels. Flax indicates an increase of 10,941 bushels and rye, 18,407 bushels, as compared with the previous week. Briefly the situation of grain in store is as follows:-

In the Western Country Elevators decreases are shown in wheat of 210,204 bushels; oats, 526,623 bushels; barley, 96,874 bushels and flax, 28,889 bushels.

In the Interior Terminal Elevators wheat shows a decrease of 30,339 bushels; oats, 127,945 bushels and barley, 9,909 bushels.

In the Public Terminal Elevators at Fort William and Port Arthur decreases are shown in wheat of 1,652,358 bushels; oats, 107,613 bushels; barley, 282,669 bushels and rye, 5,615 bushels. Flax indicates an increase of 77,563 bushels. In the Private Terminal Elevators decreases are shown in wheat of 48,822 bushels; oats, 120,380 bushels and barley, 45,935 bushels. Flax indicates an increase of 5,464 bushels and rye, 84 bushels.

In the Public Elevators in the East increases are shown in wheat of 383,412 bushels; oats, 306,314 bushels; barley, 22,735 bushels and rye, 23,997 bushels. Flax indicates a decrease of 43,197 bushels.

In the United States Atlantic Seaboard Ports increases are shown in oats and barley of 110,594 and 8,486 bushels respectively while wheat indicates a decrease of 8,000 bushels and rye, 59 bushels.

In the United States Lake Ports decreases are shown in wheat of 127,795 bushels; oats, 43,683 bushels and barley, 1,000 bushels.

The movement of grain by water for the week ending May 27th, 1921, is as follows:- Wheat, 1,826,305 bushels; oats, 1,169,892 bushels; barley, 158,051 bushels and flax, 132,892 bushels. The Canadian Lower Lake Ports received 841,379 bushels of wheat; 474,542 bushels of oats; 78,247 bushels of barley and 60,650 bushels of flax.

The inspections for the week ending May 21st, 1921, show 1,307 cars as compared with 1,441 of the previous week.

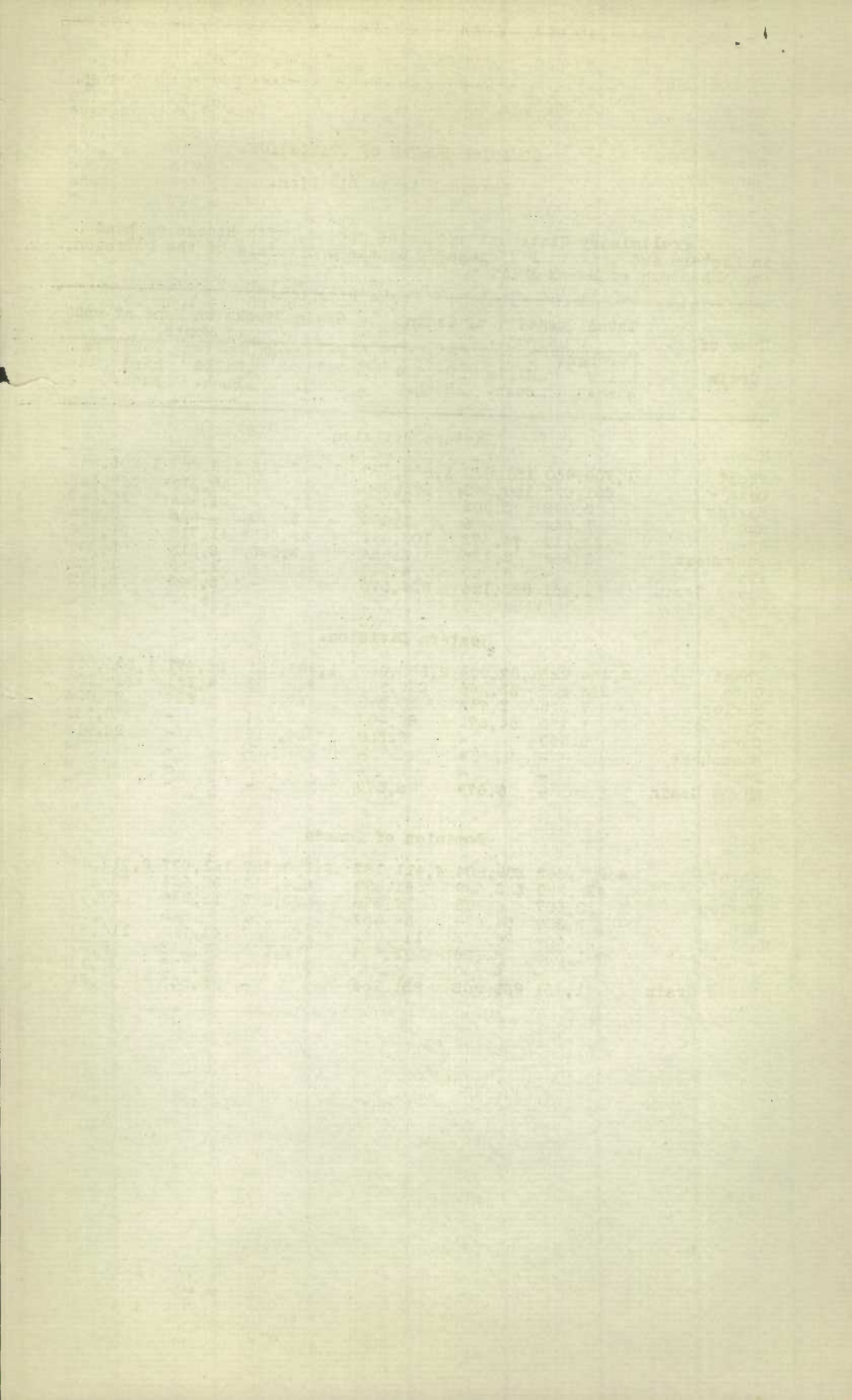
