According to returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending May 6th, 1921, the quantity of grain in store at the different Public Elevators throughout Canada, has decreased by 2,596,994 bushels in wheat; oats, 1,905,194 bushels; and barley, 245,347 bushels. Flax indicates an increase of 13,343 bushels and rye, 112,221 bushels, as compared with the previous week. Briefly the situation of grain in store is as follows:-

In the Western Country Elevators decreases are shown in wheat of 566,352 bushels; oats, 1,009,197 bushels; barley, 116,929 bushels and flax, 9,220 bushels.

In the Interior Terminal Elevators decreases are shown in wheat of 160,290 bushels; oats, 152,662 bushels; barley, 6,442 bushels and flax, 30 bushels.

In the Public Terminal Elevators at Fort William and Port Arthur a decrease is shown in wheat of 1,457,279 bushels; oats, 931,359 bushels; and barley, 388,797 bushels. Flax indicates an increase of 14,244 bushels and rye, 16,375 bushels. In the Private Terminal Elevators decreases are shown in wheat of 432,999 bushels; oats, 127,946 bushels; barley, 60,927 bushels and rye, 1,214 bushels. Flax indicates an increase of 8,349 bushels.

In the Public Elevators in the East increases are shown in wheat of 597,183 bushels; oats, 764,365 bushels; barley, 291,963 bushels and rye, 34,882 bushels.

In the United States Atlantic Seaboard Ports decreases are shown in wheat of 383,565 bushels; oats, 448,395 bushels and barley, 29,864 bushels. Rye indicates an increase of 62,178 bushels.

In the United States Lake Ports wheat shows a decrease of 193,692 bushels and barley an increase of 65,649 bushels.

The movement of grain by water for the week ending April 30th, 1921, is as follows:- Wheat, 2,986,272 bushels; oats, 2,413,187 bushels; barley, 805,773 bushels; flax, 285,051 bushels and rye, 100,000 bushels. The Canadian Lower Lake Ports received 1,740,440 bushels of wheat, 1,745,022 bushels of oats, 301,000 bushels of barley and 50,000 bushels of flax.

The inspections for the week ending May 7th, 1921, show 1,770 cars as compared with 2,719 of the previous week.

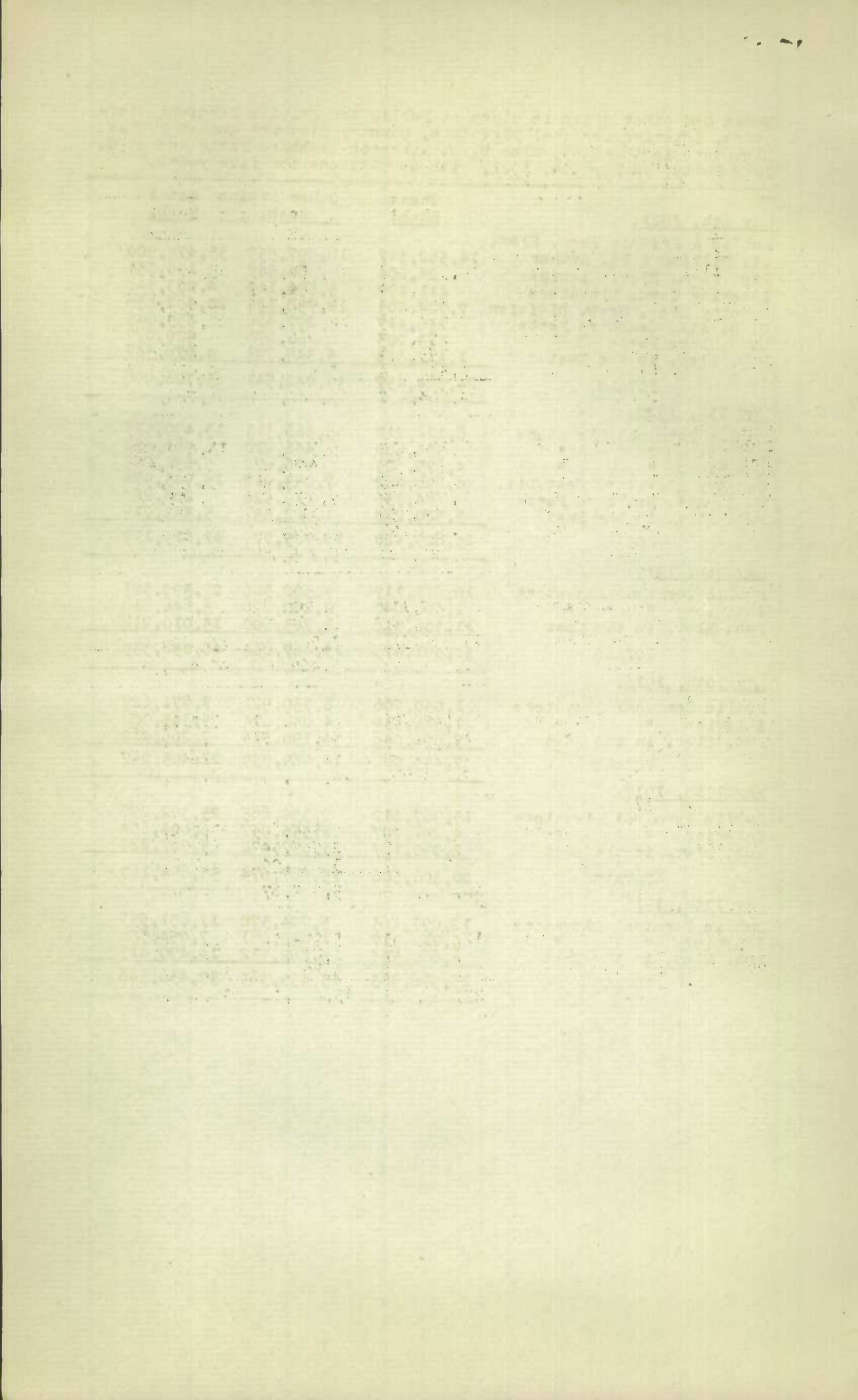
