INTERNAL TRADE BRANCH.

According to returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending June 17th, 1921, the quantity of grain in store at the different Public Elevators throughout Canada has decreased by 156,161 bushels in wheat; oats, 1,077,138 bushels and barley, 27,313 bushels. Flax and rye indicate increases of 9,545 and 149,404 bushels respectively, as compared with the previous week. Briefly the situation of grain in store is as follows:-

In the Western Country Elevators an increase is shown in wheat of 188,329 bushels; barley, 163,782 bushels and flax, 3,287 bushels. Oats indicates a decrease of 163,219 bushels.

In the Interior Terminal Elevators decrease are shown in wheat of 21,518 bushels; oats, 102,849 bushels; barley, 4,350 bushels and flax, 6 bushels.

In the Public Terminal Elevators at Fort William and Port Arthur wheat indicates a decrease of 827,762 bushels; oats, 1,008,408 bushels; barley, 259,844 bushels and flax, 24,533 bushels. Rye indicates an increase of 10,606 bushels. In the Private Terminal Elevators wheat shows a decrease of 85,764 bushels; oats, 61,387 bushels; barley, 35,453 bushels and flax, 8,157 bushels.

In the Public Elevators in the East increases are shown in wheat of 557,024 bushels; oats, 443,905 bushels; barley, 114,419 bushels; flax, 38,954 bushels and rye, 141,107 bushels.

In the United States Atlantic Seaboard Ports a decrease is shown in oats of 185,180 bushels; barley, 5,872 bushels; and rye, 2,309 bushels. Wheat indicates an increase of 113,891 bushels.

In the United States Lake Ports wheat indicates a decrease of 80,361 bushels.

The movement of grain by water for the period from June 1st, to June 14th, 1921, is as follows:- Wheat, 4,572,528 bushels; oats, 3,361,717 bushels; barley, 597,143 bushels; flax, 120,345 bushels and rye, 70,114 bushels. The Canadian Lower Lake Ports received 4,002,528 bushels of wheat; 3,221,717 bushels of oats; 50,000 bushels of barley and 12,000 bushels of flax.

The inspections for the week ending June 14th, 1921, show 1,571 cars as compared with 1,292 of the previous week.
