INTERNAL TRADE BRANCH.

According to returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending June 24th, 1921, the quantity of grain in store at the different Public Elevators throughout Canada has decreased by 992,749 bushels in wheat; oats, 1,201,956 bushels; barley, 207,825 bushels and flax, 171,155 bushels. Rye indicates an increase of 20102 bushels as compared with the previous week. Briefly the situation of grain in store is as follows:-

In the Western Country Elevators a decrease is shown in wheat of 143,122 bushels; barley, 28,611 bushels and flax, 17,451 bushels. Oats indicates an increase of 46,945 bushels.

In the Interior Terminal Elevators decreases are shown in wheat of 19,616 bushels; oats, 85,805 bushels and barley, 3,675 bushels.

In the Public Terminal Elevators at Fort William and Port Arthur wheat indicates a decrease of 282,307 bushels; oats, 738,510 bushels; barley, 78,989 bushels and flax, 80,226 bushels. Rye indicates an increase of 11,376 bushels. In the Private Terminal Elevators decreases are shown in oats of 147,386 bushels; barley, 7,663 bushels; flax, 41,779 bushels and rye, 6,340 bushels. Wheat indicates an increase of 13,564 bushels.

In the Public Elevators in the East decreases are shown in wheat of 440,874 bushels; oats, 281,088 bushels; barley, 91,087 bushels and flax, 31,699 bushels. Rye indicates an increase of 12,005 bushels.

In the United States Atlantic Seaboard Ports decreases are shown in wheat and rye of 95,394 and 3,939 bushels respectively. Oats indicates an increase of 3,888 bushels.

In the United States Lake Ports a decrease is shown in wheat of 25,000 bushels. Barley and rye indicate increases of 2,200 and 7,000 bushels respectively.

The inspections for the week ending June 21st, 1921, show 1,894 bays as compared with 1,571 of the previous week.
