CANADIAN ARMY SERVICE - WERE ENDING JULY 1st, 1951

General Summary of the activities of the Canadian Army in Europe from 1945 to 1951. This summary is based on the reports of the Canadian Army in Europe from 1945 to 1951. It covers the period from the end of the Second World War to the end of the Korean War. The summary is divided into three main sections: the Canadian Army in Europe from 1945 to 1947, the Canadian Army in Europe from 1947 to 1949, and the Canadian Army in Europe from 1949 to 1951. The summary is intended to provide a general overview of the activities of the Canadian Army in Europe during this period.

INTERNAL TRADE BRANCH.

According to returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending July 1st, 1921, the quantity of grain in store at the different Public Elevators throughout Canada has decreased in wheat by 888,855 bushels; oats, 1,779,435 bushels; Flax, 21,840 bushels and rye, 152,047 bushels. Barley indicates an increase of 238,833 bushels, as compared with the previous week. Briefly the situation of grain in store is as follows:-

In the Western Country Elevators decreases are shown in wheat of 719,580 bushels; oats, 557,750 bushels; barley, 59,848 bushels and flax, 33,896 bushels.

In the Interior Terminal Elevators decreases are shown in wheat of 44562 bushels; oats, 34,864 bushels and barley, 930 bushels.

In the Public Terminal Elevators at Fort William and Port Arthur wheat indicates a decrease of 351,282 bushels; oats, 837,590 bushels and flax, 7,545 bushels. Barley and rye show increases of 118,265 and 3,879 bushels respectively. In the Private Terminal Elevators a decrease is shown in oats of 384,194 bushels and rye, 508 bushels. Wheat, barley and flax indicate increases of 12,173, 15,037 and 6,208 bushels respectively.

In the Public Elevators in the East increases are shown in wheat of 19,257 bushels; barley, 181,507 bushels and flax, 13,393 bushels. Oats indicates a decrease of 5,994 bushels and rye, 145,804 bushels.

In the United States Atlantic Seaboard Ports increases are shown in wheat of 16,048 bushels and oats, 40,957 bushels. Barley and rye indicate decreases of 14,798 and 2,614 bushels respectively.

In the U. S. Lake Ports an increase is shown in wheat of 179,091 bushels. Barley indicates a decrease of 200 bushels and rye, 7,000 bushels.

The movement of grain by water for the period from June 15th, to 30th, 1921, is as follows;- Wheat, 2,605,836 bushels; oats, 4,063,007 bushels; barley, 539,637 bushels; flax, 270,862 bushels and rye, 46,283 bushels. The Canadian Lower Lake Ports received 2,033,974 bushels of wheat; 3,336,257 bushels of oats; 356,276 bushels of barley; 39,679 bushels of flax and 31,283 bushels of rye.

The inspections for the week ending June 30th, 1921, show 3,050 cars as compared with 1,894 of the previous week.

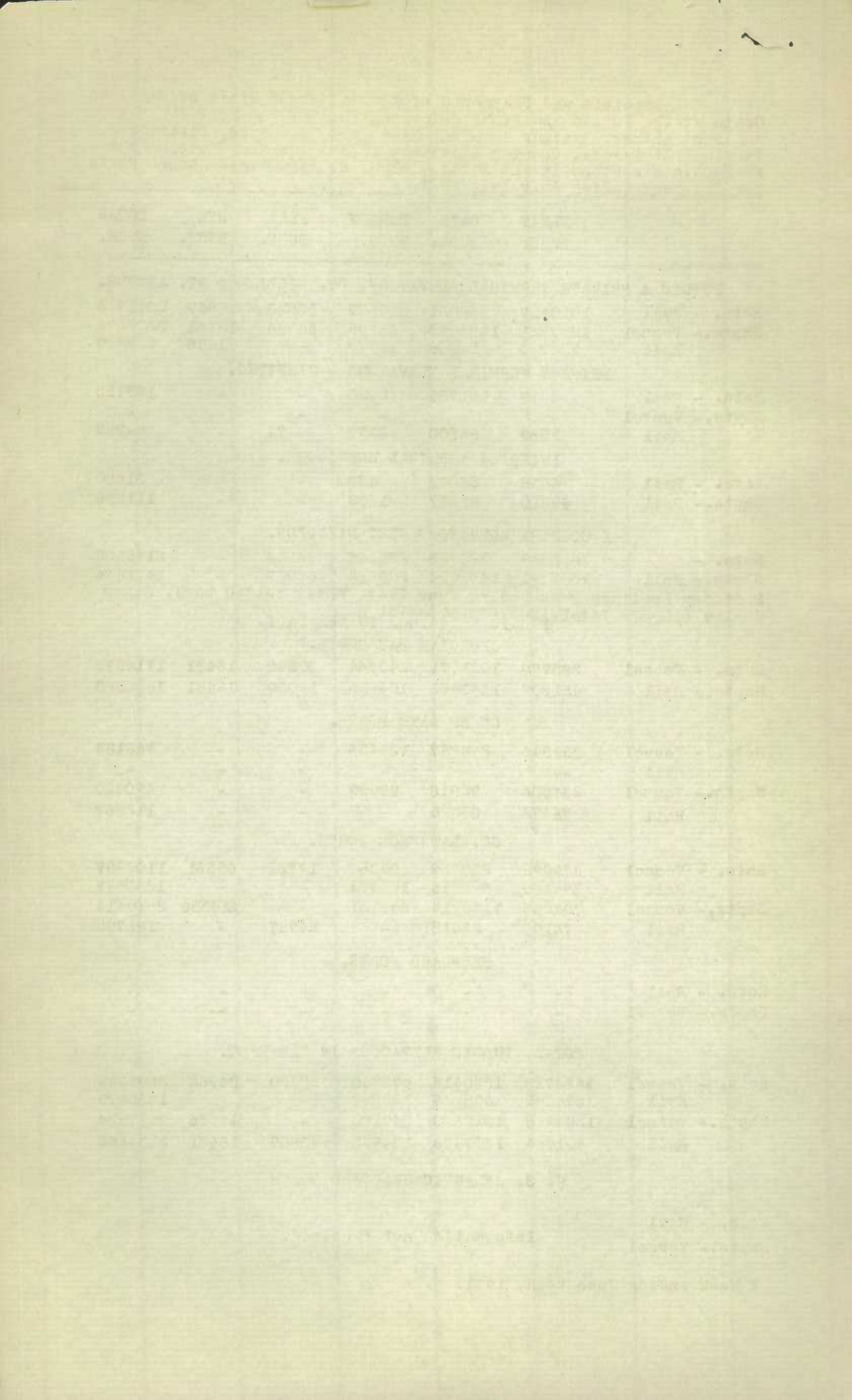
