Canadian Grain Statistics - Week ending July 15, 1921.

According to returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending July 15th, 1921, the quantity of grain in store at the different Public Elevators throughout Canada has decreased in Wheat by 1,003,061 bushels; Oats, 1216,517 bushels; Barley, 54,405 bushels and Rye 80,880 bushels. Flax shows an increase of 4,894 bushels as compared with the previous week. Briefly the situation of grain in store is as follows:-

In the Western Country Elevators decreased are shown in Wheat of 854,116 bushels; Oats, 340,651 bushels; Barley 41,255 bushels and Flax, 105,587 bushels.

In the Interior Terminal Elevators, wheat indicated a decrease of 9852 bushels; Oats 71,129 bushels; Barley 3,778 bushels, and Flax 746 bushels.

In the Public Terminal Elevators at Fort William and Port Arthur Flax shows an increase of 93,336 bushels, Wheat, Oats, Barley and Rye indicate decreases of 217,997 bushels, 109,442 bushels, 60,287 bushels and 30,126 bushels respectively. In the Private Terminal Elevators increases are shown in Wheat of 181,127 bushels; Oats, 14,090 bushels; Barley, 2,922 bushels; Flax, 17,891 bushels and Rye 1,159 bush.

In the Public Elevators in the East decreases are shown in Wheat, Oats, Barley and Rye of 98,143 Bushels, 670,934 bushels, 7,769 bushels and 46,928 bushels respectively.

In the United States Atlantic Seaboard Ports increases are shown in Wheat of 17,278 and Barley 55,762 bushels, Oats and Rye indicates decreases of 38,457 and 4,985 bushels.

In the U. S. Lake Ports a decrease is shown in Wheat of 21,358 bushels.

The movement of Grain by Water for the period from July 1st, to July 14th, 1921 is as follows:- Wheat, 2,466,861 bushels; Oats, 2,266,652 bushels; Barley, 445,900 bushels; Flax, 28,375 bushels and Rye 55,828 bushels. The Canadian Lower Lake Ports received 1,973,361 bushels of Wheat; 2,266,652 bushels of Oats; 260,899 bushels of Barley; and 41,075 bushels of Rye.

The inspections for the week ending July 15th, 1921, show 2,161 cars as compared with 2,136 cars of the previous week.
