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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING AUGUST 5th, 1921.

According to returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending August 5th, 1921, the quantity of grain in store at the different Public Elevators throughout Canada has decreased in wheat by 670,994 bushels; and oats, 333,910 bushels. Barley, flax and rye indicate increases of 358,268; 46,328 and 13,900 bushels respectively as compared with the previous week. Briefly the situation of grain in store is as follows:-

In the Western Country Elevators decreases are shown in wheat of 103,883 bushels; oats, 344,573 bushels; barley, 82,636 bushels and flax, 30,715 bushels. The quantities of grain in store at Saskatchewan are as follows: Wheat 764,688 bushels; oats, 1,176,504 bushels; barley, 117,718 bushels and flax, 174,841 bushels.

In the Interior Terminal Elevators decreases are shown in wheat of 13,470 bushels; oats, 71,978 bushels; barley, 1,476 bushels and flax, 710 bushels.

In the Public Terminal Elevators at Fort William and Port Arthur increases are in oats, flax and rye of 308,805; 66,974 and 10,629 bushels respectively. Wheat indicates a decrease of 187,999 bushels and barley, 70,191 bushels. In the Private Terminal Elevators oats shows an increase of 370,961 bushels; barley, 18,213 bushels; flax, 10,008 bushels and rye, 3,271 bushels. Wheat indicates a decrease of 166,317 bushels.

In the Public Elevators in the East decreases are shown in wheat of 207,796 bushels and oats, 509,291 bushels. Barley and flax indicate increases of 494,557 bushels and 1,446 bushels.

In the United States Atlantic Seaboard Ports decreases are shown in wheat of 36,800 bushels and oats, 87,834 bushels.

In the United States Lake Ports an increase is shown in wheat of 45,271 bushels. Barley and flax indicate decreases of 199 and 675 bushels respectively.

The inspections for the week ending August 7th, 1921, show 1,129 cars as compared with 2,512 of the previous week.
