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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING DECEMBER 2nd, 1921.

According to returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending December 2nd, 1921, the quantity of grain in Store at the different elevators throughout Canada has decreased by 3,239,921 bushels made up as follows.- Wheat 2,675,716 bushels, barley, 126,610 bushels; flax, 75,153 bushels and rye, 362,442 bushels. Oats indicates an increase of 473,269 bushels.

In the Western Country Elevators increases are shown in oats, barley and rye of 381,689; 42,795 and 14,832 bushels respectively. Wheat shows a decrease of 447,295 bushels and flax 15,211 bushels. Of the total quantity in store viz 36,790,553 bushels the following were held by the different Prairie Provinces:-

The receipts of wheat at Country Elevators were 5,874,034 bushels and the shipments 6,308,022 bushels. The Platform Loadings for the week ending November 21st, 1921, were as follows.- Wheat, 945,653 bushels and other grains 279,658 bushels.

In the Interior Terminal Elevators decreases are shown in wheat of 174,762 bushels; flax, 118 bushels and rye, 779 bushels. Oats and barley indicate increases of 3,423 and 1,029 bushels respectively.

In the Public and Private Terminal Elevators at Fort William and Port Arthur decreases are shown in all grains; wheat, 5,701,520 bushels; oats, 776,304 bushels; barley, 104,778 bushels; flax, 135,859 bushels and rye, 411,415 bushels. The receipts of all grains were 10,213,975 bushels and the shipments by vessel 16,835,175 bushels and by rail 508,676 bushels.

The Private Terminal Elevators at Winnipeg show increases in wheat of 15,919 bushels; oats, 50,448 bushels and rye, 554 bushels. Barley indicates a decrease of 6,693 bushels.

In the Public Elevators in the East increases are shown in all grains; wheat, 518,759 bushels; oats, 634,126 bushels; barley, 45,145 bushels; flax, 76,035 bushels and rye, 24,957 bushels. The receipts of wheat were 3,066,986 bushels by vessel and 252,100 bushels by rail while the shipments were the shipments were 522,967 bushels by vessel and 2,267,547 bushels by rail.

The quantity of U. S. Grain in Store at the Public Elevators in the East was 4,018,724 bushels compared with 2,064,314 last year. The bulk of the former was made up of wheat and corn viz 885,139 and 2,395,256 bushels respectively.

In the U. S. Lake Ports increases are shown in wheat of 3,556,313 bushels; oats, 99,955 bushels while barley shows a decrease of 94,293 bushels.

The U. S. Atlantic Seaboard Ports show decreases in wheat and barley of 443,130 bushels and 9,815 bushels respectively. Oats shows an increase of 79,932 bushels and rye, 9,409 bushels.
