CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING DECEMBER 16th, 1921.

According to returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending December 16th, 1921, the quantity of grain in store at the different elevators throughout Canada has increased by 7,002,636 bushels made up as follows.-
Wheat, 3,797,663 bushels; oats, 2,517,064 bushels; barley, 431,359 bushels; flax 36,788 bushels and rye, 219,762 bushels.

In the Western Country Elevators increases are shown in oats of 727,127 bushels; barley, 93,677 bushels; flax, 12,727 bushels and rye, 16,921 bushels. Wheat indicates a decrease of 158,167 bushels. Of the total quantity in store viz 38,566,586 bushels the following were held by the different Prairie Provinces.-

The receipts of wheat at Country Elevators were 8,992,623 bushels and the shipments 9,124,307 bushels. The Platform Loadings for the week ending December 7th, 1921, were as follows.- Wheat 364,266 bushels and other grains 158,001 bushels.

The Interior Terminal Elevators show increases in wheat, oats and flax of 243,972, 95,406 and 93 bushels respectively. Barley indicates a decrease of 4,333 bushels.

In the Public and Private Terminal Elevators at Fort William and Port Arthur increases are shown in all grains; wheat, 234,587 bushels; oats, 749,145 bushels; barley, 61,552 bushels; flax, 56,003 bushels and rye, 39,790 bushels. The receipts of all grains were 8,916,688 bushels and the shipments by vessel 6,789,355 bushels and by rail, 986,256 bushels.

The Private Terminal Elevators at Winnipeg show increases in wheat and oats of 191,355 bushels and 109 bushels respectively. Rye indicates a decrease of 516 bushels.

In the Public Elevators in the East increases are shown in wheat of 289,385 bushels; barley, 167,695 bushels and rye, 7,054 bushels. Oats shows a decrease of 167,228 bushels and flax, 32035 bushels. The receipts of wheat were 1,283,153 bushels by vessel and 881,470 bushels by rail while the shipments were 493,220 bushels by vessel and 1,382,020 bushels by rail.

The quantity of United States Grain in Store at the Public Elevators in the East was 3,861,472 bushels compared with 1,763,367 bushels last year. The bulk of the former was made up of wheat and corn viz 865,397 and 2,063,230 bushels respectively.

In the U. S. Lake Ports increases are shown in wheat of 3,057,778 bushels; oats, 1,066,961 bushels and barley, 109,617 bushels.

The U. S. Atlantic Seaboard Ports increases are shown in oats of 45,544 bushels; barley, 3,151 bushels and rye, 156,513 bushels. Wheat indicates a decrease of 61,247 bushels.
