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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING SEPTEMBER 30th, 1921.

According to returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending September 30th, 1921, the quantity of grain in store at the different Elevators throughout Canada has increased by 2,090,870 bushels made up as follows.- Wheat 1,951,303 bus. and rye 139,567 bushels. Oats, barley and flax indicate decreases of 1,067,841; 271,490 and 113,898 bushels respectively.

In the Western Country Elevators increases are shown in barley of 106,779 bushels and rye, 74,967 bushels. Wheat, oats and flax show decreases of 485,378; 164,106 and 29,356 bushels respectively. Of the total quantity in store viz. 14,648,139 bushels the following were held by the different Prairie Provinces.-Saskatchewan Alberta Manitoba

The receipts of wheat at Country Elevators were 6,986,346 bushels and shipments 7,463,164 bushels. The quantity loaded over the loading platforms for the week ending September 21st, 1921, was as follows.-Wheat 702,831 bus. and other grains 118,072 bushels.

The Interior Terminal Elevators show decreases in oats of 18,053 bushels; barley, 93 bushels and rye, 2,354 bushels. Wheat indicates an increase of 17,042 bushels and flax, 151 bushels.

In the Public and Private Terminal Elevators at Fort William and Port Arthur decreases are shown in oats of 803,070 bushels; barley, 279,093 bushels; flax, 47,138 bushels and rye, 108,777 bushels. Wheat shows an increase of 1,052,982 bushels. The receipts of all grains were 8,383,627 bushels and shipments by vessel 8,102,302 bushels and by rail 366,420 bushels.

In the Private Terminal Elevators at Winnipeg decreases are shown in wheat of 83 bushels; oats, 15,819 bushels and barley 15,143 bus.

The quantity of grain in store at the Public Elevators in the East has increased in wheat by 688,385 bushels and rye, 174,612 bushels. Oats shows a decrease of 64,835 bushels; barley, 173,989 bushels and flax, 27,566 bushels. The receipts of wheat were 2,619,249 bushels by vessel and 988,268 bushels by rail while the shipments were 1,202,263 bushels by vessel and 1,721,863 bushels by rail.

The quantity of U.S. Grain in Store at Public Elevators in the East was 12,179,137 bushels compared with 1,110,995 bushels of the previous year. The bulk of the former was made up of wheat and corn viz. 5,240,928 and 5,015,481 bushels respectively.

The U.S. Lake Ports show an increase in wheat of 439,054 bushels. Barley and flax indicate decreases of 11,586 bushels and 9,989 bushels.

In the U.S. Atlantic Seaboard Ports increases are shown in wheat of 239,301 bushels; barley, 1,635 bushels and rye, 1,119 bushels. Oats indicate a decrease of 1,958 bushels.
