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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING OCTOBER 28th, 1921.

According to returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending October 28th, 1921, the quantity of grain in store at the different elevators throughout Canada has increased by 11,723,749 bushels made up as follows.- Wheat 9,410,446 bushels; oats, 1,411,219 bushels; barley, 406,450 bushels; flax, 283,900 bushels and rye, 211,724 bushels,

In the Western Country Elevators increases are shown in wheat of 3,459,093 bushels; oats, 753,598 bushels; barley, 96,907 bushels; flax, 214,703 bushels and rye, 63,871 bushels. Of the total quantity in store viz 35,879,179 bushels the following were held by the different Prairie Provinces.- Saskatchewan Alberta Manitoba.

The receipts of wheat at Country Elevators were 17,475,055 bushels and the shipments 13,970,429 bushels. The Platform Loadings for the week ending October 21st, 1921, were as follows.- Wheat 1,396,799 bushels and other grains 616,654 bushels.

The Interior Terminal Elevators show increases in oats of 12,899 bushels and barley, 4,925 bushels while wheat shows a decrease of 958 bushels.

In the Public and Private Terminal Elevators, Fort William and Port Arthur increases are shown in wheat of 5,309,815 bushels; oats, 878,225 bushels; barley, 215,420 bushels; flax, 51,998 bushels and rye, 156,372 bushels. The receipts of all grains were 16,387,522 bushels and the shipments 9,339,751 bushels by vessel and 435,941 bushels by rail.

The Private Terminal Elevators at Winnipeg show decreases in wheat of 24 bushels; oats, 7,186 bushels and flax, 137 bushels. Barley indicates an increase of 5,142 bushels.

In the Public Elevators in the East increases are shown in wheat of 827,541 bushels; barley, 89,845 bushels and flax, 18,018 bushels. Oats and rye indicate decreases of 225,317 and 104,036 bushels respectively. The receipts of wheat were 2,751,729 bushels by vessel and 833,321 bushels by rail while the shipments were 1,588,854 bushels by vessel and 1,406,601 bushels by rail.

The quantity of U. S. Grain in store at the Public Elevators in the East was 7,835,456 bushels compared with 1,723,845 bushels last year. The bulk of the former was made up of wheat and corn viz 1,557,938 and 5,482,709 bushels respectively.

The U. S. Lake Ports show an increase in wheat of 81,262 bushel. Barley and flax indicate decreases of 5,779 and 682 bushels respectively.

In the U. S. Atlantic Seaboard Ports a decrease is shown in wheat of 266,283 bushels and an increase in rye of 95,517 bushels.
