WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending November 17, 1939 increased 6,198,715 bushels as compared with the previous week and increased 179,790,664 bushels when compared with the corresponding week in 1938. The amount in store was reported as 356,669,776 bushels compared with 350,471,061 bushels for the previous week and 176,879,112 bushels for the week of November 18, 1938. The stocks of 356,669,776 bushels include 14,539,643 bushels of Durum wheat.

CANADIAN WHEAT IN CANADA

The wheat stocks in elevators in Canada for the week ending November 17, 1939 were 338,149,776 bushels compared with 333,026,061 bushels for the previous week and 170,831,112 bushels for the corresponding week last year.

Stocks of wheat in Canadian elevators were located as follows: Western Country Elevators 143,920,000; Interior Terminals 20,995,278; Vancouver-New Westminster 10,875,032; Victoria 389,664; Churchill 2,484,585; Fort William and Port Arthur 75,024,456; Eastern Elevators Lake and Seaboard Ports 37,543,991 and 18,995,848 bushels respectively.

Increases were noted at Western Country Elevators of 10,030,000; Vancouver-New Westminster 1,586,772; Victoria 45,755 and Eastern Elevators Lake Ports 837,367 bushels, while decreases were noted at Interior Terminals of 637,370; Fort William and Port Arthur 1,890,323 and Eastern Elevators Seaboard Ports 806,688 bushels.

Wheat in rail transit amounted to 22,098,144 bushels and the amount in transit on the lakes was 5,822,778 bushels for the week ending November 17, 1939 compared with 9,174,767 and 6,240,617 bushels for the same period last year.

CANADIAN WHEAT IN THE UNITED STATES

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 18,520,000 bushels, an increase of 1,075,000 bushels over the previous week when 17,445,000 bushels were reported. This Canadian wheat was located at the following ports: Buffalo 2,710,000; Buffalo Afloat 940,000; Erie 1,686,000; Erie Canal 187,000; New York 4,849,000; Albany 4,412,000; Philadelphia 814,600; Boston 1,855,000 and Baltimore 1,067,000 bushels.

Increases were noted at Buffalo Afloat of 940,000; Erie Canal 112,000; New York 377,000; Albany 133,000; Philadelphia 471,000; Boston 149,000 and Baltimore 504,000 bushels, while Buffalo and Erie decreased 392,000 and 219,000 bushels respectively.

For the same week a year ago the Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 6,048,000 bushels distributed as follows: Buffalo 565,000; Buffalo Afloat 984,000; Erie 2,178,000; Erie Canal 318,000; New York 835,000; New York Afloat 180,000 and Albany 988,000 bushels.



Export Clearances

During the week ending November 17, 1939 the export clearances overseas of wheat from Canadian and United States ports amounted to 2,996,116 bushels while the imports into the United States for consumption and milling in bond were 190,000 bushels, totalling 3,186,116 bushels. This compared with 5,451,487 bushels for the corresponding week in 1938. The accumulated total for the period from August 1 to November 17, 1939 was 35,572,655 bushels and the imports into the United States for the same period were 3,303,207 bushels amounting in all to 38,875,862 bushels compared with 57,642,815 bushels a year ago.

Coarse Grains - For the above week 414,238 bushels of oats, 595,000 bushels of barley and 701,507 bushels of rye were cleared for export while the accumulated totals for the period ending November 17 were as follows: Oats 1,361,501; barley 5,700,701; flaxseed 7 and rye 2,164,137 bushels.

Primary Movement

Wheat receipts in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending November 17, 1939 amounted to 7,065,568 bushels, a decrease of 2,192,924 bushels from the previous week when 9,258,492 bushels were marketed. During the corresponding week a year ago the receipts were 4,675,524 bushels. By provinces the receipts for the week ending November 17, 1939 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1938: Manitoba 412,166 (329,043); Saskatchewan 3,584,166 (1,794,445); Alberta 3,069,236 (2,552,036) bushels.

Marketings in the three Prairie Provinces for the sixteen weeks from August 1, 1939 to November 17, 1939 as compared with the same period in 1938 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1938: Manitoba 49,412,305 (39,252,079); Saskatchewan 189,194,842 (95,699,655); Alberta 93,223,973 (103,853,564) bushels. For the sixteen weeks ending November 17, 1939 and the same period in 1938, 331,831,120 and 238,805,298 bushels were received from the farms.



EASTERN ELEVATORS: United States grain and soya bean stocks were 336,119 bushels lower than at a comparable date last year. Decreases were noted in oats of 395,898; rye 45 and corn 280,026 bushels, while wheat, barley and soya beans decreased 267,641; 479 and 71,730 bushels respectively.
