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WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending January 19, 1940 decreased 4,514,131 bushels as compared with the previous week and increased 180,033,912 bushels when compared with the corresponding week in 1939. The amount in store was reported as 341,644,260 bushels compared with 346,158,391 bushels for the previous week and 161,610,348 bushels for the week of January 20, 1939. The stocks of 341,644,260 bushels include 13,129,827 bushels of Durum wheat.

CANADIAN WHEAT IN CANADA

The wheat stocks in elevators in Canada for the week ending January 19, 1940 were 305,606,167 bushels compared with 308,642,349 bushels for the previous week and 154,765,348 bushels for the corresponding week last year.

Stocks of wheat in Canadian elevators were located as follows: Western Country Elevators 140,340,000; Interior Terminals 22,874,097; Vancouver-New Westminster 15,894,397; Victoria 739,750; Prince Rupert 1,019,807; Churchill 2,484,585; Fort William and Fort Arthur 54,339,187; Eastern Elevators Lake and Seaboard Ports 41,267,601 and 18,062,136 bushels respectively.

Increases were noted at Vancouver-New Westminster 64,123; Victoria 6,167; Prince Rupert 17,554 and Fort William and Fort Arthur 1,381,964 bushels, while decreases were shown at Western Country Elevators of 1,750,000; Interior Terminals 13,871 and Eastern Elevators Lake and Seaboard Ports 3,960,302 and 1,497,434 bushels respectively.

Wheat in rail transit amounted to 8,064,608 bushels for the week ending January 19, 1940 compared with 4,222,934 bushels for the same period last year.

CANADIAN WHEAT IN THE UNITED STATES

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 36,038,092 bushels, a decrease of 1,477,950 bushels from the previous week when 37,516,042 bushels were reported. This Canadian wheat was located at the following ports: Duluth 2,731,877; Buffalo 3,956,000; Buffalo Afloat 3,442,000; Erie 25,000; Erie Afloat 1,034,319; New York 4,746,000; Albany 7,598,000; Philadelphia 2,622,000; Boston 1,828,000; Portland 449,896 and Baltimore 7,605,000 bushels.

Decreases were noted at Buffalo of 4,000; Buffalo Afloat 250,000; Erie Afloat 831,000; Philadelphia 93,000; Boston 96,000; Baltimore 7,000 and Portland 191,950 bushels.

For the same week a year ago the Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 6,845,000 bushels distributed as follows: Buffalo 548,000; Buffalo Afloat 3,441,000; Erie 1,449,000; New York 420,000; New York Afloat 44,000; Albany 851,000 and Philadelphia 92,000 bushels.

Export Clearances

During the week ending January 19, 1940 the export clearances overseas of wheat from Canada and United States ports amounted to 4,943,617 bushels while the imports into the United States for consumption and milling in bond were 279,000 bushels, totalling 5,222,617 bushels. This compared with 2,455,610 bushels for the corresponding week in 1939. The accumulated total for the period from August 1, 1939 to January 19, 1940 was 63,701,288 bushels and the imports into the United States for the same period were 4,899,169 bushels amounting in all to 68,600,457 bushels compared with 78,700,321 bushels a year ago.

Primary Movement

Wheat receipts in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending January 19, 1940 amounted to 892,764 bushels, a decrease of 356,441 bushels from the previous week when 1,249,205 bushels were marketed. During the corresponding week a year ago the receipts were 1,241,384 bushels. By provinces the receipts for the week ending January 19, 1940 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1939: Manitoba 49,508 (84,954): Saskatchewan 388,314 (391,307): Alberta 454,942 (765,123) bushels.

Marketings in the three Prairie Provinces for the twenty-five weeks from August 1, 1939 to January 19, 1940 as compared with the same period in 1939 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1939: Manitoba 50,639,583 (40,444,231): Saskatchewan 203,839,325 (102,832,478): Alberta 111,516,371 (114,149,479) bushels. For the twenty-five weeks ending January 19, 1940 and the same period in 1939, 365,995,279 and 257,426,188 bushels were received from the farms.

EASTERN ELEVATORS: United States grain and soya bean stocks were 2,015,203 bushels lower than at a comparable date last year. Decreases were noted in oats of 782,862; rye 45 and corn 1,772,040 bushels, while increases were shown in wheat of 496,259; barley 4,072 and soya beans 39,433 bushels.
