WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending February 23, 1940 decreased 4,256,365 bushels as compared with the previous week and increased 176,979,961 bushels when compared with the corresponding week in 1939. The amount in store was reported as 325,767,681 bushels compared with 330,024,046 bushels for the previous week and 148,787,720 bushels for the week of February 24, 1939. The stocks of 325,767,681 bushels include 12,284,075 bushels of Durum wheat.

CANADIAN WHEAT IN CANADA

The wheat stocks in elevators in Canada for the week ending February 23, 1940 were 296,349,256 bushels compared with 298,938,621 bushels for the previous week and 144,816,720 bushels for the corresponding week last year.

Stocks of wheat in Canadian elevators were located as follows: Western Country Elevators 120,830,000; Interior Terminals 22,808,733; Vancouver-New Westminster 15,853,829; Victoria 807,644; Prince Rupert 1,136,107; Churchill 2,484,585; Fort William and Port Arthur 74,920,926; Eastern Elevators Lake and Seaboard Ports 32,512,355 and 18,538,933 bushels respectively.

Increases were noted at Interior Terminals of 63,131; Victoria 13,800; Fort William and Port Arthur 3,664,539 and Eastern Elevators Seaboard Ports 20,092 bushels, while decreases were shown at Western Country Elevators of 1,710,000; Vancouver-New Westminster 334,363 and Eastern Elevators Lake Ports 2,117,966 bushels.

Wheat in rail transit amounted to 6,456,144 bushels for the week ending February 23, 1940 compared with 1,637,957 bushels for the same period last year.

CANADIAN WHEAT IN THE UNITED STATES

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 29,418,425 bushels, a decrease of 1,667,000 bushels from the previous week when 31,085,425 bushels were reported. This Canadian wheat was located at the following ports: Duluth 2,731,877; Buffalo 3,252,000; Buffalo Afloat 1,835,000; Erie Afloat 1,034,319; New York 2,123,000; Albany 7,598,000; Philadelphia 1,791,000; Boston 1,914,000; Portland 477,229 and Baltimore 6,662,000 bushels.

Decreases were noted at Buffalo of 398,000; Buffalo Afloat 736,000; Erie 25,000; New York 137,000; Philadelphia 202,000; Baltimore 279,000 and Portland 58,000 bushels while Boston increased 168,000 bushels.

For the same week a year ago the Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 3,971,000 bushels distributed as follows: Buffalo 659,000; Buffalo Afloat 1,578,000; Erie 677,000 New York 63,000; New York Afloat 18,000; Albany 851,000; Philadelphia 92,000; Boston 15,000 and Baltimore 18,000 bushels.

Export Clearances

During the week ending February 23, 1940 the export clearances overseas of wheat from Canada and United States ports amounted to 2,811,328 bushels while the imports into the United States for consumption and milling in bond were 232,000 bushels, totalling 3,043,328 bushels. This compared with 1,696,175 bushels for the corresponding week in 1939. The accumulated total for the period from August 1, 1939 to February 23, 1940 was 80,483,479 bushels and the imports into the United States for the same period were 5,697,806 bushels amounting in all to 86,181,285 bushels compared with 88,415,658 bushels a year ago.

Primary Movement

Wheat receipts in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending February 23, 1940 amounted to 1,340,798 bushels, a decrease of 73,453 bushels from the previous week when 1,414,251 bushels were marketed. During the corresponding week a year ago the receipts were 581,247 bushels. By provinces the receipts for the week ending February 23, 1940 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1939: Manitoba 67,248 (46,562); Saskatchewan 609,557 (175,277); Alberta 663,993 (359,408) bushels.

Marketings in the three Prairie Provinces for the thirty weeks from August 1, 1939 to February 23, 1940 as compared with the same period in 1939 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1939: Manitoba 50,380,598 (40,761,292); Saskatchewan 206,906,239 (104,026,197); Alberta 114,505,280 (116,352,727) bushels. For the thirty weeks ending February 23, 1940 and the same period in 1939, 371,792,117 and 261,140,216 bushels were received from the farms.

World shipments for the week ending February 24, 1940 amounted to 9,011,000 bushels as compared with shipments of 7,540,000 bushels for the previous week and 10,472,000 bushels for the corresponding week last year. North American shipments showed a decrease from the previous week of 116,000 bushels while Argentine shipments were higher by 1,715,000 bushels.

During the first thirty weeks of the present crop year world shipments amounted to 256,191,000 bushels as compared with 332,176,000 bushels for the corresponding week last year. North American shipments were 111,446,000 bushels as compared with 144,880,000 bushels for the same period in 1938-39. Argentine shipments amounted to 100,689,000 bushels during the first thirty weeks of the present crop year as compared with only 38,824,000 bushels for the same period in 1938-39.

WEEKLY AVERAGE SHIPMENTS

The following table shows the weekly average shipments of wheat and wheat flour for the first thirty weeks of the present crop year with comparative figures for 1938-39.

According to the above, weekly average shipments of wheat and wheat flour amounted to 8.5 million bushels as compared with 11.1 million bushels for the corresponding weeks in 1938-39. North American weekly average shipments were 3.7 million bushels as compared with 4.8 million bushels in the same weeks last year.
