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WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending March 15, 1940 decreased 2,280,263 bushels as compared with the previous week and increased 172,533,246 bushels when compared with the corresponding week in 1939. The amount in store was reported as 315,280,914 bushels compared with 317,561,177 bushels for the previous week and 142,747,668 bushels for the week of March 17, 1939. The stocks of 315,280,914 bushels include 11,346,102 bushels of Durum wheat.

CANADIAN WHEAT IN CANADA

The wheat stocks in elevators in Canada for the week ending March 15, 1940 were 289,599,950 bushels compared with 291,178,708 bushels for the previous week and 139,646,668 bushels for the corresponding week last year.

Stocks of wheat in Canadian elevators were located as follows: Western Country Elevators 120,390,000; Interior Terminals 22,638,869; Vancouver-New Westminster 15,699,040; Victoria 567,200; Prince Rupert 1,136,049; Churchill 2,484,585; Fort William and Port Arthur 78,658,090; Eastern Elevators Lake and Seaboard Ports 22,535,306 and 17,522,958 bushels respectively.

Decreases were noted at Interior Elevators of 152,032; Vancouver-New Westminster 117,949; and Eastern Elevators Lake and Seaboard Ports 2,578,305 and 523,195 bushels respectively, while increases were shown at Western Country Elevators of 365,000 and Fort William and Port Arthur 652,332 bushels.

Wheat in rail transit amounted to 7,967,853 bushels for the week ending March 15, 1940 compared with 2,715,827 bushels for the same period last year.



CANADIAN WHEAT IN THE UNITED STATES

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 25,680,964 bushels, a decrease of 701,505 bushels from the previous week when 26,382,469 bushels were reported. This Canadian wheat was located at the following ports: Duluth 2,731,877; Buffalo 2,394,000; Buffalo Afloat 1,176,000; Erie 422,000; Erie Afloat 637,347; New York 755,000; Albany 7,598,000; Philadelphia 1,955,000; Boston 1,350,000; Portland 890,740 and Baltimore 5,771,000 bushels.

Decreases were noted at Buffalo of 117,000; Buffalo Afloat 213,000; New York 177,000; Philadelphia 54,000; Boston 149,000 and Baltimore 334,000 bushels, while Portland increased 342,495 bushels.

For the same week a year ago the Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 3,101,000 bushels distributed as follows: Buffalo 252,000; Buffalo Afloat 1,209,000; Erie 451,000; New York 355,000; New York Afloat 18,000; Albany 771,000; Philadelphia 36,000 and Boston 9,000 bushels.



Export Clearances

During the week ending March 15, 1940 the export clearances overseas of wheat from Canada and United States ports amounted to 4,776,026 bushels while the imports into the United States for consumption and milling in bond were 179,000 bushels, totalling 4,955,026 bushels. This compared with 2,011,702 bushels for the corresponding week in 1939. The accumulated total for the period from August 1, 1939 to March 15, 1940 was 94,237,759 bushels and the imports into the United States for the same period were 6,299,463 bushels amounting in all to 100,537,222 bushels compared with 94,674,802 bushels a year ago.

Primary Movement

Wheat receipts in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending March 15, 1940 amounted to 1,778,970 bushels, an increase of 90,537 bushels over the previous week when 1,688,435 bushels were marketed. During the corresponding week a year ago the receipts were 1,275,403 bushels. By provinces the receipts for the week ending March 15, 1940 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1939: Manitoba 121,973 (136,815); Saskatchewan 945,625 (552,590); Alberta 711,372 (585,998) bushels.

Marketings in the three Prairie Provinces for the thirty-three weeks from August 1, 1939 to March 15, 1940 as compared with the same period in 1939 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1939: Manitoba 50,723,845 (41,149,838); Saskatchewan 209,408,925 (105,594,674); Alberta 116,559,798 (118,289,139) bushels. For the thirty-three weeks ending March 15, 1940 and the same period in 1939, 376,692,568 and 265,033,651 bushels were received from the farms.

Worries about the future of the country and the world have been growing. 


