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WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending April 12, 1940 decreased 1,460,821 bushels as compared with the previous week and increased 173,640,982 bushels when compared with the corresponding week in 1939. The amount in store was reported as 309,534,631 bushels compared with 310,995,452 bushels for the previous week and 135,893,749 bushels for the week of April 14, 1939. The stocks of 309,534,631 bushels include 10,647,789 bushels of Durum wheat.

CANADIAN WHEAT IN CANADA

The wheat stocks in elevators in Canada for the week ending April 12, 1940 were 288,664,671 bushels compared with 289,358,146 bushels for the previous week and 135,893,649 bushels for the corresponding week last year.

Stocks of wheat in Canadian elevators were located as follows: Western Country Elevators 113,875,000; Interior Terminals 22,257,309; Vancouver-New Westminster 15,789,585; Victoria 599,741; Prince Rupert 1,136,049; Churchill 2,494,610; Fort William and Port Arthur 81,220,840; Eastern Elevators Lake and Seaboard Ports 17,906,358 and 17,680,486 bushels respectively.

Decreases were noted at Western Country Elevators of 6,265,000; Interior Terminals 203,251 and Eastern Elevators Lake and Seaboard Ports 1,131,636 and 319,987 bushels respectively, while increases were shown at Vancouver-New Westminster of 125,540; Victoria 19,130 and Fort William and Port Arthur 948,877 bushels.

Wheat in rail transit amounted to 15,704,693 bushels for the week ending April 12, 1940 compared with 2,798,136 bushels for the same period last year.

CANADIAN WHEAT IN THE UNITED STATES

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 20,869,960 bushels, a decrease of 767,346 bushels from the previous week when 21,637,306 bushels were reported. This Canadian wheat was located at the following ports: Duluth 2,731,877; Buffalo 2,432,000; Erie 662,000; New York 399,000; Albany 7,276,000; Philadelphia 1,990,823; Boston 899,127; Portland 952,796 and Baltimore 3,526,337 bushels.

Decreases were noted at Buffalo Afloat of 283,000; New York 125,000; Albany 322,000; Boston 232,260 and Baltimore 269,400 bushels, while increases were shown at Buffalo of 269,000 and Philadelphia 195,314 bushels.

For the same week a year ago the Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 1,032,000 bushels distributed as follows: Buffalo 117,000; Erie 121,000; New York 324,000; Albany 450,000 and Philadelphia 20,000 bushels.

Export Clearances

During the week ending April 12, 1940 the export clearances overseas of wheat from Canada and United States ports amounted to 2,423,887 bushels while the imports into the United States for consumption and milling in bond were 110,000 bushels, totalling 2,533,887 bushels. This compared with 1,119,138 bushels for the corresponding week in 1939. The accumulated total for the period from August 1, 1939 to April 12, 1940 was 106,451,498 bushels and the imports into the United States for the same period were 6,941,790 bushels amounting in all to 113,393,288 bushels compared with 99,145,848 bushels a year ago.

Primary Movement

Wheat receipts in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending April 12, 1940 amounted to 1,346,436 bushels a decrease of 518,503 bushels over the previous week when 1,864,939 bushels were marketed. During the corresponding week a year ago the receipts were 1,442,613 bushels. By provinces the receipts for the week ending April 12, 1940 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1939: Manitoba 125,775 (199,866); Saskatchewan 794,516 (682,704); Alberta 426,145 (560,043) bushels.

Marketings in the three Prairie Provinces for the thirty-seven weeks from August 1, 1939 to April 12, 1940 as compared with the same period in 1939 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1939: Manitoba 51,035,725 (41,735,490); Saskatchewan 213,470,498 (107,528,192); Alberta 119,249,242 (120,465,124) bushels. For the thirty-seven weeks ending April 12, 1940 and the same period in 1939, 383,755,465 and 269,728,806 bushels were received from the farms.

EASTERN ELEVATORS: United States grain and soya bean stocks were 1,512,622 bushels lower than at a comparable date last year. Decreases were noted in barley of 54; corn 2,166,917 and soya beans 36,536 bushels, while increases were shown in wheat of 640,521; oats 49,764 and barley 600 bushels.
