WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending July 19, 1940 decreased 133,091 bushels as compared with the previous week and increased 182,478,761 bushels when compared with the corresponding week in 1939. The amount in store was reported as 282,118,158 bushels compared with 282,251,249 bushels for the previous week and 99,639,397 bushels for the week of July 21, 1939. The stocks of 282,118,158 bushels include 8,707,778 bushels of Durum wheat.

CANADIAN WHEAT IN CANADA

The wheat stocks in elevators in Canada for the week ending July 19, 1940 were 256,445,170 bushels compared with 256,150,062 bushels for the previous week and 92,431,397 bushels for the corresponding week last year.

Stocks of wheat in Canadian elevators were located as follows: Western Country Elevators 56,680,000; Interior Terminals 18,582,312; Vancouver-New Westminster 15,198,606; Victoria 611,827; Prince Rupert 1,136,049; Churchill 2,494,610; Fort William and Port Arthur 75,468,165; Eastern Elevators Lake Ports 39,879,856 and Eastern Elevators Seaboard Ports 21,330,385 bushels.

Decreases were noted at Western Country Elevators of 2,395,000; Vancouver 38,148; Victoria 647 and Eastern Elevators Seaboard Ports 61,165 bushels, while increases were shown at Interior Terminals of 284,273; Fort William and Port Arthur 3,650,454 and Eastern Elevators Lake Ports 988,306 bushels.

For the week ending July 19, 1940 the amount of wheat in transit on the lakes was 2,618,625 bushels and in transit by rail 22,444,735; compared with 4,495,009 in transit on the lakes and 7,284,412 in transit by rail for the corresponding period in 1939.



CANADIAN WHEAT IN THE UNITED STATES

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 25,672,988 bushels, a decrease of 428,199 bushels from the previous week when 26,101,187 bushels were reported. This Canadian wheat was located at the following ports: Duluth 2,731,877; Buffalo 5,097,000; Buffalo Afloat 421,000; Erie 2,010,000; Erie Canal 576,000; Chicago 47,000; New York 533,000; New York Afloat 117,000; Albany 5,913,000; Philadelphia 1,151,614; Boston 2,275,979; Portland 1,211,145 and Baltimore 1,084,377 bushels. In Transit U.S.A. amounted to 2,503,996 bushels.

Increases were shown at Buffalo Afloat of 76,000; Erie Canal Afloat 287,000; Albany 476,000 and Boston 31,956 bushels, while decreases were noted at Buffalo of 189,000; New York 290,000; New York Afloat 97,000; Philadelphia 40,000 and In Transit U.S.A. 683,155 bushels.

For the same week a year ago the Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 7,208,000 bushels distributed as follows; Buffalo 1,387,000; Buffalo Afloat 261,000; Erie 720,000; Erie Canal 535,000; New York 267,000; New York Afloat 40,000 and Albany 3,998,000 bushels.



Export Clearances

During the week ending July 19, 1940 the export clearances overseas of wheat from Canada amounted to 2,689,439 bushels. This compared with 1,650,752 bushels for the corresponding week in 1939. The accumulated total for the period from August 1, 1939 to July 19, 1940 was 148,918,253 bushels compared with 126,436,819 bushels a year ago.

Primary Movement

Wheat receipts in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending July 19, 1940 amounted to 3,829,238 bushels, an increase of 345,232 bushels over the revised figure of the previous week when 4,174,470 bushels were marketed. During the corresponding week a year ago the receipts were 1,981,306 bushels. By provinces the receipts for the week ending July 19, 1940 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1939: Manitoba 172,402 (130,605); Saskatchewan 2,541,820 (1,019,750); Alberta 1,115,016 (830,951) bushels.

Marketings in the three Prairie Provinces for the fifty-one weeks from August 1, 1939 to July 19, 1940 as compared with the same period in 1939 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1939: Manitoba 52,992,663 (44,106,455); Saskatchewan 233,474,817 (117,178,843); Alberta 130,726,943 (127,877,999) bushels. For the fifty-one weeks ending July 19, 1940 and the same period in 1939, 417,194,423 and 289,163,297 bushels were received from the farms.




EASTERN ELEVATORS: United States grain and soya bean stocks were 1,209,147 bushels lower than at a comparable date last year. Decreases were noted in wheat of 221,109; oats 56,658; barley 13,922; corn 712,714 and soya beans 204,902 bushels, while rye increased 158 bushels.
