WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending September 20, 1940 increased 26,027,844 bushels as compared with the previous week and increased 102,946,039 bushels when compared with the corresponding week in 1939. The amount in store was reported as 357,893,847 bushels compared with 331,866,003 bushels for the previous week and 254,947,808 bushels for the week of September 12, 1939. The stocks of 357,893,847 bushels include 8,918,961 bushels of Durum wheat.

CANADIAN WHEAT IN CANADA

The wheat stocks in elevators in Canada for the week ending September 20, 1940 were 321,702,653 bushels compared with 296,318,016 bushels for the previous week and 245,566,808 bushels for the corresponding week last year.

Stocks of wheat in Canadian elevators were located as follows: Western Country Elevators 108,300,000; Interior Terminals 23,557,114; Vancouver-New Westminster 15,464,765; Victoria 637,887; Prince Rupert 1,135,164; Churchill 2,494,610; Fort William and Port Arthur 81,473,766; Eastern Elevators Lake Ports 44,070,803 and Eastern Elevators Seaboard Ports 21,654,659 bushels.

Increases were noted at Western Country Elevators of 20,520,000; Interior Terminals 147,302; Fort William and Port Arthur 1,085,412 and Eastern Elevators Seaboard Ports 187,824 bushels, while decreases were shown at Vancouver-New Westminster of 158,023; Victoria 74,667 and Eastern Elevators Lake Ports 468,146 bushels.

For the week ending September 20, 1940 the amount of wheat in transit on the lakes was 5,847,834 bushels and in transit by rail 19,066,051 compared with 5,255,007 in transit on the lakes and 38,145,133 in transit by rail for the corresponding period in 1939.



CANADIAN WHEAT IN THE UNITED STATES

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 36,191,814 bushels, an increase of 690,881 bushels over the previous week when 35,500,333 bushels were reported. This Canadian wheat was located at the following ports: Duluth 6,341,652; Buffalo 6,670,000; Buffalo Afloat 315,000; Erie 1,956,000; Erie Canal 548,000; Chicago 29,000; Ogdensburg 384,315; New York 2,608,000; New York Afloat 675,000; Albany 8,896,000; Philadelphia 1,017,522; Boston 2,231,999; Portland 1,211,145 and Baltimore 1,084,377 bushels. In Transit U.S.A. amounted to 2,223,204 bushels.

Increases were shown at Duluth of 645,399; Buffalo Afloat 150,000; New York 582,000; New York Afloat 279,000; Albany 159,000 and In Transit U.S.A. 147,482 bushels, while decreases were noted at Buffalo of 95,000; Erie Canal 1,170,000 and Chicago 7,000 bushels.

For the same week a year ago the Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 9,381,000 bushels distributed as follows: Buffalo 1,893,000; Buffalo Afloat 731,000; Erie 461,000; Erie Canal 237,000; New York 2,347,000 and Albany 3,712,000 bushels.



Export Clearances

During the week ending September 20, 1940 the export clearances overseas of Canadian wheat amounted to 1,375,503 bushels. This compared with 4,110,848 bushels for the corresponding week in 1939. The accumulated total for the period from August 1, 1940 to September 20, 1940 was 12,317,361 bushels compared with 18,904,759 bushels a year ago.

Primary Movement

Wheat receipts in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending September 20, 1940 amounted to 27,886,842 bushels, an increase of 11,459,285 bushels over the revised figure of the previous week when 16,427,557 bushels were marketed. During the corresponding week a year ago the receipts were 37,675,205 bushels. By provinces the receipts for the week ending September 20, 1940 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1939: Manitoba 5,096,617 (2,566,334); Saskatchewan 17,263,287 (24,786,608); Alberta 5,526,938 (10,322,263) bushels.

Marketings in the three Prairie Provinces for the seven weeks from August 1, 1940 to September 20, 1940 as compared with the same period in 1939 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1939: Manitoba 18,109,752 (40,790,009); Saskatchewan 57,965,495 (103,662,825); Alberta 17,569,147 (38,205,184) bushels. For the seven weeks ending September 20, 1940 and the same period in 1939, 93,644,394 and 182,658,016 bushels were received from the farms.

EASTERN ELEVATORS: United States grain and soya bean stocks were 926,456 bushels lower than at a comparable date last year. Decreases were noted in wheat of 541,603; oats 115,526; barley 4,068 and corn 267,812 bushels, while rye and soya beans increased 158 and 2,395 bushels respectively.



Duluth: Receipts of Canadian banded grain at Duluth by rail for the weeks ending August 24, 31; September 7, 14 and 21 amounted to wheat 38,282; 982,183; 1,290,308; 2,385,882 and 645,599 bushels respectively. Lake Shipments of wheat for the weeks ending August 24, 31, September 7 and 14 amounted to 530,000; 713,611; 241,000 and 247,668 bushels respectively.

For the period from August 1, 1940 to September 21, 1940 rail receipts amounted to wheat 5,342,054 bushels, while shipments for the same period amounted to 1,732,279 bushels.
