WHEAT STOCKS IN STORE

Canadian wheat in store for the week ending August 8, 1941 increased 359,075 bushels as compared with the previous week and increased 182,239,878 bushels when compared with the corresponding week in 1940. The amount in store was reported as 464,197,157 bushels compared with 463,838,082 bushels for the previous week and 281,957,279 bushels for the week of August 9, 1940. The stocks of 464,197,157 bushels include 1,977,088 bushels of Durum wheat.

CANADIAN WHEAT IN CANADA

The wheat stocks in elevators in Canada for the week ending August 8, 1941 were 432,749,672 bushels compared with 432,503,783 bushels for the previous week and 253,221,181 bushels for the corresponding week last year.

Stocks of wheat in Canadian elevators were located as follows: Western Country Elevators 210,215,000; Interior Terminals 26,195,266; Vancouver-New Westminster 17,633,194; Victoria 990,978; Prince Rupert 1,207,975; Churchill 2,617,396; Fort William and Port Arthur 81,990,623; Eastern Elevators Lake Ports 41,713,565 and Eastern Elevators Seaboard Ports 24,832,263 bushels.

Decreases were noted at Western Country Elevators of 2,415,000 and Eastern Elevators Seaboard Ports 97,131 bushels, while increases were shown at Interior Terminals of 140,346; Vancouver-New Westminster 40,872; Fort William and Port Arthur 239,584 and Eastern Elevators Lake Ports 1,589,264 bushels.

For the week ending August 8, 1941 the amount of wheat in transit on the lakes was 1,916,122 bushels, and in transit by rail 23,437,290 compared with 4,169,398 in transit on the lakes and 16,137,270 in transit by rail for the corresponding period in 1940.



CANADIAN WHEAT IN THE UNITED STATES

Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 31,447,485 bushels, a decrease of 113,186 bushels from the previous week when 31,334,299 bushels were reported. This Canadian wheat was located at the following ports: Duluth 10,401,232; Erie 2,233,000; Erie Canal Afloat 766,000; Buffalo 5,206,000; Buffalo Afloat 81,000; Albany 2,826,000; New York 3,067,000; New York Afloat 706,000; Boston 1,886,364; Portland 1,306,044; Philadelphia 472,279; Baltimore 929,328 and In Transit U.S.A. 1,567,238 bushels.

Increases were shown at Erie Canal Afloat of 166,000; Buffalo Afloat 81,000; New York 15,546; New York Afloat 103,120; Baltimore 243,585 and In Transit U.S.A. 403,975 bushels, while decreases were noted at Duluth of 532,369; Buffalo 125,064; Albany 51 and Boston 242,556 bushels.

For the same week a year ago the Canadian wheat in the United States amounted to 28,736,098 bushels distributed as follows: Duluth 2,731,877; Erie 1,980,000; Erie Canal Afloat 845,000; Chicago 45,000; Buffalo 5,123,000; Buffalo Afloat 80,000; Albany 6,914,000; New York 827,000; New York Afloat 399,000; Boston 2,273,362; Portland 1,211,145; Philadelphia 1,064,189; Baltimore 1,084,377 and In Transit U.S.A. 4,158,148 bushels.



EXPORT CLEARANCES

During the week ending August 8, 1941 the export clearances overseas of Canadian wheat amounted to 2,415,382 bushels. This compared with 1,506,622 bushels for the corresponding week in 1940.

PRIMARY MOVEMENT

Wheat receipts in the Prairie Provinces for the week ending August 8, 1941 amounted to 304,278 bushels, a decrease of 6,803,277 bushels from the revised figures of the previous week when 7,607,555 bushels were marketed. During the corresponding week a year ago the receipts were 2,406,317 bushels. By provinces the receipts for the week ending August 8, 1941 were as follows, figures within brackets being those for 1940: Manitoba 226,804 (162,706); Saskatchewan 185,548 (1,107,890); Alberta 391,926 (1,135,721) bushels.



World shipments for the week ending August 9, 1941 amounted to 6,443,000 bushels as compared with shipments of 6,984,000 bushels for the previous week and 4,792,000 bushels for the corresponding week last year. North American shipments showed a decrease from the previous week of 521,000 bushels while Argentine shipments were lower by 20,000 bushels.



EASTERN ELEVATORS: United States grain and soya bean stocks were 1,685,407 bushels lower than at a comparable date last year. Decreases were noted in barley of 4; rye 190; corn 1,857,131 and soya beans 19,656 bushels, while wheat and oats increased 136,794 and 54,780 bushels respectively.
