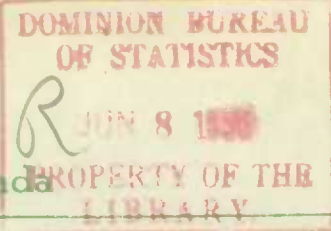

Stocks of Canadian wheat in store or in transit in North America at midnight May 25, 1950 totalled 111,911,749 bushels. This represented a decrease of 5,620,166 bushels compared with the total at May 18, 1950.
