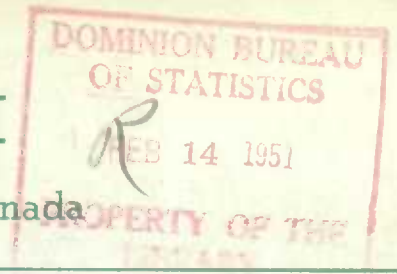

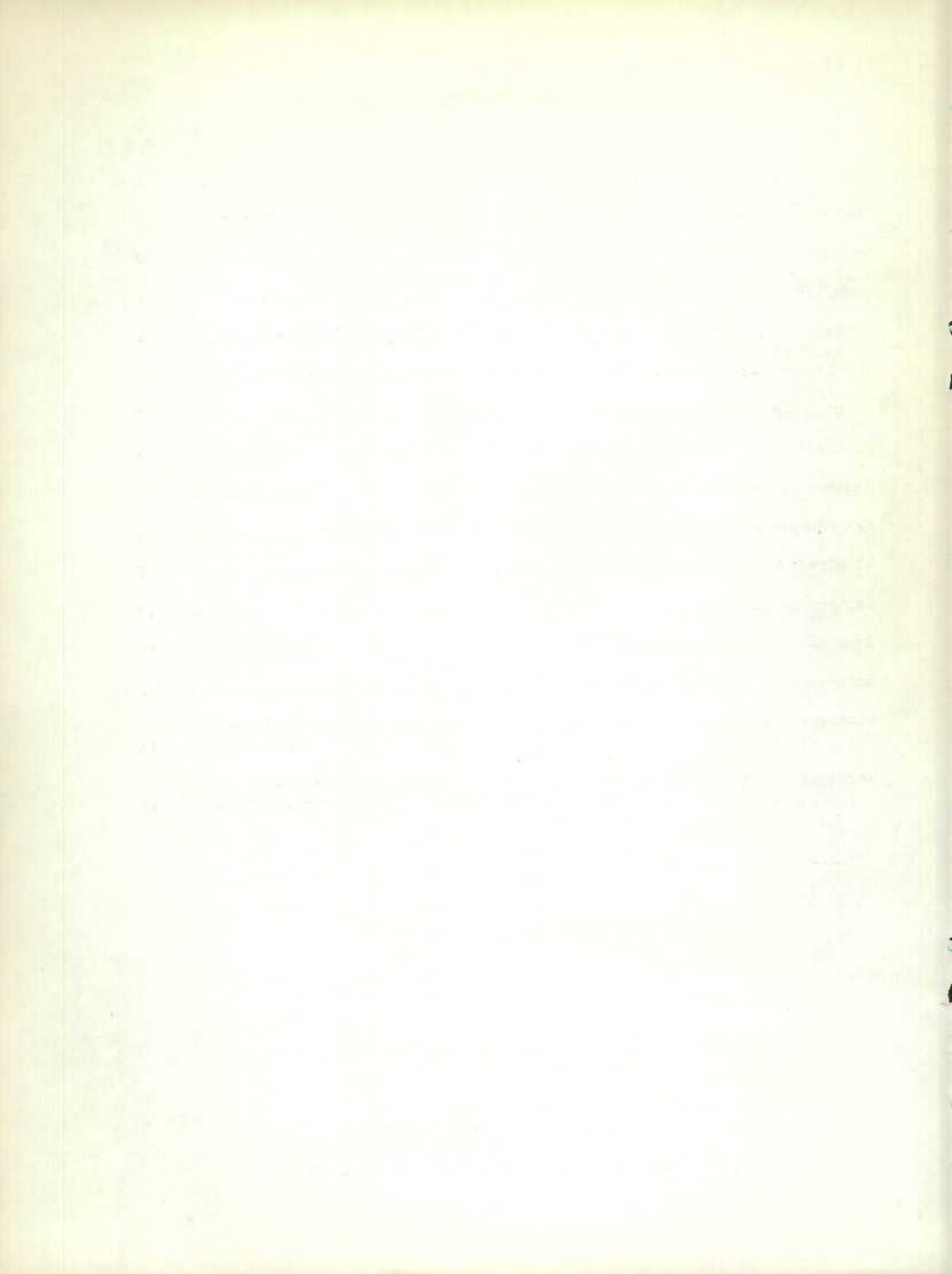

Stocks of Canadian Wheat in store or in transit in North America at midnight February 1, 1951 totalled 218,535,882 bushels. This represented a decrease of 4,314,671 bushels compared with the total at January 25, 1951.
