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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING APRIL 25th, 1924.

Returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ended April 25th, 1924, show a net decrease of 4,122,930 bushels from the previous week. The stocks in store for the week were as follows:- Wheat 99,434,277 bushels; Oats 30,154,645 bushels; Barley 5,258,158 bushels; Flax 1,614,897 bushels; and Rye 4,179,533 bushels, a total of 140,641,510 bushels. Decreases took place in Wheat of 1,559,112 bushels; Oats 1,854,291 bushels; Barley 253,624 bushels; Flax 176,132 bushels and Rye 279,771 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS. A net decrease is shown in all grains in store from the previous week of 2,424,262 bushels made up as follows: Wheat 1,734,746 bushels; Oats 445,339 bushels; Barley 141,111 bushels; Flax 54,764 bushels and Rye 48,302 bushels. The total grain in store was 68,756,348 bushels compared with 71,180,610 bushels last week.

The following table shows the quantities of grain in store at the Country Elevators in each of the Prairie Provinces, Western Ontario and British Columbia on April 18th, 1924, with a comparison for the previous week and the same period last year.

INTERIOR TERMINAL ELEVATORS (CALGARY, SASKATOON & MOOSE JAW). A net decrease is shown in all grains in store of 165,119 bushels. Wheat, Oats, Barley and Rye show decreases of 124,944 bushels; 36,190 bushels; 4,157 bushels and 1,155 bushels respectively while Flax shows an increase of 1,327 bushels.

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VANCOUVER HARBOUR COMMISSIONERS' ELEVATOR. Wheat and Oats show increases of 282,891 bushels and 91 bushels respectively. Barley and Rye remained the same as the previous week.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE TERMINAL ELEVATORS (FT. WILLIAM AND PT. APTHUR). A decrease is shown in all grains in store over the previous week of 11,833,274 bushels. Wheat shows a decrease of 10,931,077 bushels; Oats 957,979 bushels; and Flax 125,150 bushels. Barley and Rye show increases of 121,903 bushels and 59,029 bushels.

WINNIPEG PRIVATE TERMINAL ELEVATORS. An increase is shown in all grains of 154,586 bushels made up as follows:- Wheat 100,273 bushels; Oats 46,940 bushels; Barley 4,913 bushels and Flax 2,455 bushels.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST (CANADIAN GRAIN). A net decrease is shown in the grains in store of 54,619 bushels. Decreases are as follows:- Oats 222,977 bushels; Barley 79,765 bushels and Rye 2,148 bushels. Wheat shows an increase of 250,271 bushels.

The Receipts of wheat at the above elevators were 947,587 bushels and 119,699 bushels by Vessel and Rail respectively. Georgian Bay Ports received 656,432 bushels and Lower Lake Ports 291,155 bushels by Vessel and St. Lawrence Ports received 119,699 bushels by Rail. The total grain receipts were 1,245,492 bushels by Vessel and 186,711 bushels by Rail. The former amount is credited to Georgian Bay Ports and Lower Lake Ports, viz., 656,432 and 589,060 bushels respectively. St. Lawrence Ports received 133,571 bushels and Seaboard Ports 53,340 bushels by Rail.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST (U.S. GRAIN). The quantity of U. S. grain in store amounted to 715,394 bushels compared with 1,207,930 bushels last year. The quantities in store by the different classes of elevators were as follows:-


