CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING SEPTEMBER 28th, 1923.

Returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending September 28th, 1923, show an increase in all grains in store of 15,022,079 bushels over the previous week. The amounts in Store for the week were:- Wheat 30,362,884 bushels; Oats 3,978,901 bushels; Barley 3,006,216 bushels; Flax 404,297 bushels; Rye 2,904,946 bushels; a total of 40,717,244 bushels. Increases were as follows:- Wheat 15,437,545 bushels; Oats 699,409 bushels; Barley 610,313 bushels; Flax 92,469 bushels; Rye 132,373 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS. A large increase took place in the amount in Store over the previous week of 9,205,181 bushels made up as follows:- Wheat 8,218,193 bushels; Oats 554,451 bushels; Barley 199,645 bushels; Flax 130,415 bushels; Rye 102,211 bushels.

The following table shows the quantities of grain in Store in Country Elevators in each of the Prairie Provinces and in Western Ontario and British Columbia on September 24th, 1923, with a comparison for the previous week also the same period last year.

THE INFERIOR TERMINAL ELEVATORS (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW, & CALGARY). Wheat shows an increase of 49,079 bushels over the previous week, while Oats figures indicate a decrease of 1,943 bushels. Barley, Flax and Rye remain the same as previous week. The net increase amounts to 47,096 bushels.

VANCOUVER HARBOUR COMMISSIONERS' ELEVATOR. An increase is shown in Wheat of 31,379 bushels; Oats decreased 6,220 bushels from the previous week. The net increase in all grains is therefore, 25,159 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE TERMINAL ELEVATORS (F.R. WILLIAM & PT. ARTHUR). All grains show increases with the exception of Flax which decreased 37,946 bushels. The increases were as follows:- Wheat 4,410,235 bushels; Oats 366,492 bushels; Barley 199,971 bushels; Rye 78,079 bushels. A net increase is shown in all grains of 5,016,829 bushels.

PRIVATE TERMINAL ELEVATORS. The Stocks show a net increase of 13,020 bushels in all grains over the previous week. Wheat and Barley show 17,435 and 2,397 bushels increase respectively while Oats decreased 6,812 bushels.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST. A net increase is shown in all Grains of 222,454 bushels. Wheat showed an increase of 513,131 bushels while Oats, Barley and Rye showed decreases of 212,857; 66,752; and 11,118 bushels respectively.

The total Receipts of Wheat at the above elevators were 2,742,442 bushels by Vessel and 1,065,027 bushels by Rail. The bulk of the Vessel Receipts are shown at Georgian Bay Ports amounting to 1,871,994 bushels; Lower Lake Ports 537,943 bushels; St. Lawrence Ports 332,505 bushels; while the Rail Receipts are shown for the St. Lawrence Ports, viz. Montreal. The total grain Receipts amounted to 3,253,849 bushels by Vessel and 1,087,991 bushels by Rail. Georgian Bay Ports received 2,027,309 bushels; St. Lawrence Ports 657,392 bushels and Lower Lake Ports 569,148 bushels, all by Vessel. The Rail Receipts is credited to St. Lawrence. U. S. GRAIN IN PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST. The U. S. Grain in Store was 7,652,779 bushels compared with 10,427,814 bushels for the same week last year.

UNITED STATES LAKE PORTS (BUFFALO & DULUTH). The amount in store shows a net increase of 154,389 bushels. Decreases were shown in Wheat of 48,073 bushels and Rye 39,799 bushels while Oats showed an increase of 5,292 bushels and Barley 236,969 bushels.

UNITED STATES ATLANTIC SEABOARD PORTS. Increases are shown in all grains of 337,971 bushels made up as follows:- Wheat 246,156 bushels; Oats 1,000 bushels; Barley 37,848 bushels and Rye 52,965 bushels.

DULUTH. The Receipts of Bonded Grain for the week ending September 28th, 1923 amounted to Wheat 60,260 bushels; Oats 5,292 bushels; Barley 39,036 bushels; and Rye 4,713 bushels, a total of 109,301 bushels. The Shipments were Wheat 108,670 bus. and Rye 46,000 bus., a total of 154,670 bushels. The quantity received for the period from September 1st to 28th were as follows: Wheat 202,577 bus., Barley 71,081 bus., Rye 32,294 bus., Oats 12,765 bus., a total amounting to 318,717 bus.. The shipments were 108,670 bushels of Wheat and 46,000 bushels of Rye, making a total of 154,670 bushels.
