CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING JULY 4th, 1924.

Returns showing stocks of grain in store at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending July 4th, 1924, show a decrease of 4,974,189 bushels from the previous week. The stocks at the end of the week were as follows:- Wheat 40,665,972 bushels; Oats 21,595,460 bushels; Barley 2,470,569 bushels; Flax 750,793 bushels and Rye 2,563,436 bushels; a total of 68,027,230 bushels. Decreases are shown in wheat of 4,102,250 bushels; Oats 753,900 bushels; Barley 135,619 bushels and Flax 6,020 bushels, while Rye shows an increase of 18,600 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS. The total grain shows a decrease of 5,624,235 bushels from the previous week made up as follows:- Wheat 3,534,063 bushels; Oats 1,720,842 bushels; Barley 89,151 bushels; Flax 56,158 bushels and Rye 224,016 bushels. The total quantity in store was 22,732,344 bushels compared with 28,357,079 bushels last week.

The following table shows the quantities of grain in store at the Country Elevators in each of the Prairie Provinces, Western Ontario and British Columbia on June 27th, 1924, with a comparison for the previous week and the same period last year.



INTERIOR TERMINAL ELEVATORS (CALGARY, MOOSE JAW & SASKATOON). A decrease is shown in the total grain in store of 81,837 bushels, made up as follows:- Wheat 31,666 bushels; Oats 40,849 bushels; Barley 3,793 bushels, and Rye 520 bushels.

VANCOUVER HARBOUR COMMISSIONERS' ELEVATOR. Wheat shows a decrease of 643,959 bushels; Barley 1,542 bushels and Rye 1,692 bushels, while Oats shows an increase of 13,780, making a net decrease of 633,413 bushels. The total grain in store was 643,719 bushels compared with 1,237,132 for the previous week.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE TERMINAL ELEVATORS (PT. WILLIAM AND PT. ARTHUR). A net increase is shown in the total grain in store of 1,440,353 bushels. Increases are shown in Oats 1,213,702 bushels; Barley 22,407 bushels; Flax 35,807 bushels, and Rye 183,970 bushels, while Wheat decreased 15,033 bushels. The amount of grain in store at the Head of the Lakes was 27,151,327 bushels compared with 25,710,474 bushels.

WINNIPEG PRIVATE TERMINAL ELEVATORS. The total grain in store shows a net increase of 128 bushels. Wheat showed an increase of 3,104 bushels, while Oats and Barley decreased 2,976 bushels.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST. (CANADIAN GRAIN) A net decrease is shown in the total grain in store of 267,770 bushels. Decreases took place in Wheat of 352,516 bushels and Barley 42,233 bushels. Increases are noted in Oats of 50,673 bushels, Flax 14,331 bushels and Rye 61,970 bushels.

6,811,867 bushels and 279,853 bushels of grain were received at the above elevators by Vessel and Rail during the week. Of the foregoing amounts 5,317,262 bushels and 214,405 bushels was Wheat. The receipts of the above by classes of Ports were as follows:-

CANADIAN SEABOARD PORTS (MONTREAL AND QUEBEC) The total grain in store shows a decrease of 352,004 bushels, made up as follows: Wheat 212,506 bushels; Oats 123,218 bushels; and Barley 16,280 bushels and Rye 13,853 bushels. There was no movement of grain at the Canadian Atlantic Seaboard Ports. The overseas shipments for the above ports according to Elevator returns amounted to - Wheat 3,098,921 bushels; Oats 323,024 bushels, and Barley 232,485 bushels, a total 3,654,430 bushels

The shipments of U.S. Grain overseas from the Port of Montreal according to elevator returns were as follows:- Wheat 142,553 bushels and Rye 68,571 bushels a total of 211,124 bushels.



U. S. LAKE PORTS. A net increase is shown in the total grain in store of 217,418 bushels. Oats and Barley show decreases of 126,481 and 85,747 bushels respectively, while Wheat and Rye show increases of 417,495 bushels and 12,151 bushels.

U. S. ATLANTIC SEABOARD PORTS. The total grain in these ports shows a net decrease of 30,337 bushels. Decreases took place in Oats of 136,230 bushels and Rye 13,263 bushels, while increases are noted in Wheat of 49,393 bushels and Barley of 69,763 bushels.

DULUTH. The receipts of bonded grain by rail at Duluth for the week ended July 3, 1924, were as follows:- Wheat 21,895 bushels; Oats 19,364 bushels; Barley 4,253 bushels, Rye 12,151 bushels, a total of 57,663. The shipments amounted to 2,116 bushels. For the period from September 1st, 1923, to July 3rd, 1924, the Receipts and Shipments were as follows:-




