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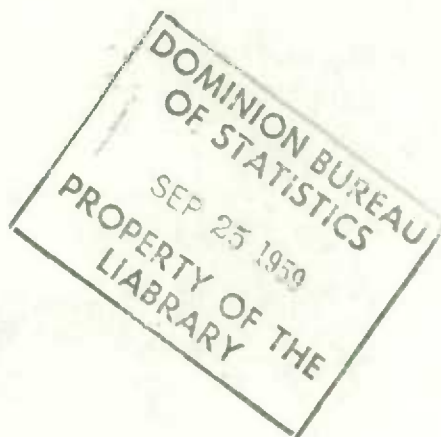

Handlings of United States Grain at Eastern Elevators

The export forwarding of United States grains through Eastern Canadian elevators during August and early September dropped off from the June - July level with only 4.9 million bushels loaded to overseas vessels from August 5 to September 9. Since the opening of the 1959 season of navigation on the Great Lakes, Eastern elevators have shipped 22.0 million of United States grain overseas, moved 2.6 million to Canadian domestic - corn and soybeans for processing, and returned 2.8 million on a transfer forwarding basis. All of this movement has been under Board of Grain Commissioners' control and scheduled not to interfere with the forwarding of Canadian grain for export.

The grain composition of this movement is shown in the following table.
