Rapeseed Handlings - Crop Year 1960-61

Canada's substantially heavier 1960 rapeseed crop coupled with an active export demand gave rise to the heaviest movement of this oilseed so far in its relatively brief history as a significant commercial grain on the prairies. Reported marketings through licensed channels totalled 9.6 million bushels, the major portion of this moved through country elevators as indicated in the summary table below. Export shipments during the crop year amounted to 8.1 million bushels with the heaviest consignments to Italy, 2.9 million bushels and France, 2.3 million bushels. Japan purchased 0.9 million bushels followed by Netherlands 0.8 million bushels, West Germany 0.6 million bushels, Belgium-Luxembourg 0.3 million bushels, and the United Kingdom 0.2 million bushels. The bulk of the export shipments 7.9 million bushels went via the Pacific Seaboard but 0.2 million bushels moved through St. Lawrence-Atlantic ports. Reports indicated a domestic processing of approximately 0.8 million bushels and a year-end carryover in licensed storage of 0.5 million bushels at July 31, 1961.

The statistical table does not represent an exact accounting balance of the stocks and handlings through the licensed system. The marketing figures are net bushels basis the country elevator dockage assessment; this dockage assessment could be and frequently was altered by cleaning to meet the strict export standards. The data are presented in this form, however, as the statistical report of the basic handling operations.
