Rapeseed^{1/} Handlings - Crop Year 1961-62

Marketings of Canadian rapeseed through the licensed elevator system increased .5 million for the 1961-62 crop year totalling more than 10 million bushels. However, overseas clearances of this oilseed at 6.9 million bushels indicate a decline compared to the 1960-61 volume. Italy remained the major customer for Canadian rapeseed during the crop year, with Japan and the Netherlands our other principal markets. The entire 1961-62 overseas movement cleared ex Pacific Coast ports. Domestic usage of 1.4 million bushels also reflects a moderate increase over the previous crop year's volume.

The statistical table does not represent an exact accounting balance of the stocks and handlings through the licensed system. The marketing figures are net bushels basis the country elevator dockage assessment; this dockage assessment could be and frequently was altered by cleaning to meet the strict export standards. The data are presented in this form, however, as the statistical report of the basic handling operations.

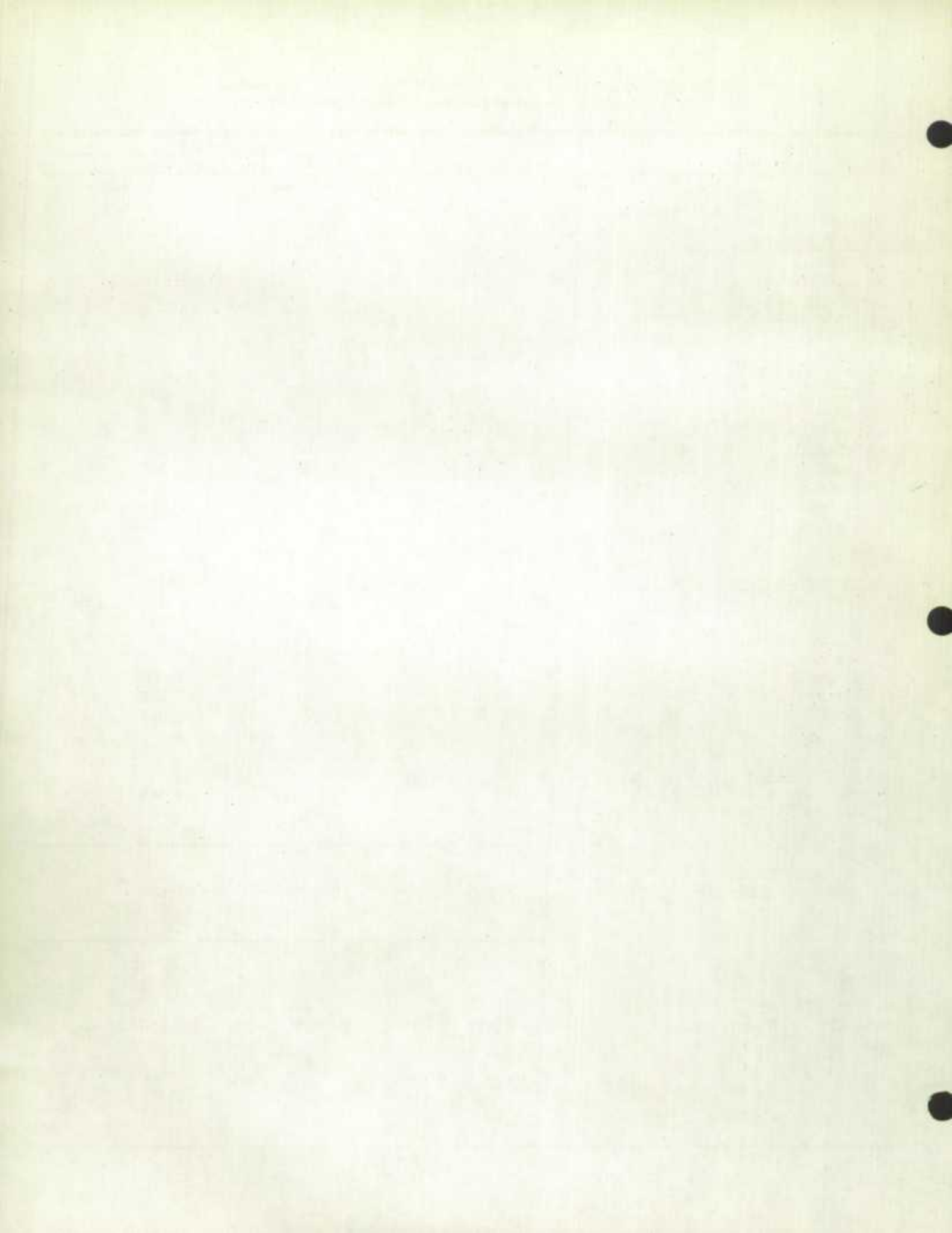
