CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING AUGUST 15th, 1924.

Returns showing stocks of grain in store at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the week ending August 15th, 1924, show a net decrease of 4,144,544 bushels from the previous week. The stocks for the week were as follows:- Wheat 25,466,659 bushels; Oats 16,256,483 bushels; Barley 1,300,628 bushels; Flax 291,269 bushels and Rye 1,954,570 bushels. Decreases are shown as follows - Wheat 2,891,491 bushels; Oats 612,607 bushels; Barley 409,631 bushels; Flax 46,236 bushels and Rye 184,579 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS. The total grain in store shows a net decrease of 938,305 bushels made up as follows:- Wheat 728,962 bushels; Oats 128,817 bushels; Barley 35,094 bushels; Flax 14,266 bushels; and Rye 31,166 bushels. The total quantity in store was 7,942,172 bushels compared with 8,880,477 bushels for the previous week.

The following table shows the quantities of grain in store at the Country Elevators in each of the Prairie Provinces, Western Ontario and British Columbia on August 8th, 1924, with a comparison for the previous week and the same period last year.

INTERIOR TERMINAL ELEVATORS. (CALGARY, MOOSE JAW AND SASKATOON). A net decrease is shown in the total grain in store of 151,890 bushels made up of wheat and Oats viz. 58,811 and 94,122 bushels respectively. Barley shows an increase of 1,043 bushels.

VANCOUVER HARBOUR COMMISSIONERS' ELEVATOR. A net decrease is shown in the total grain in store of 79,959 bushels made up as follows:- Wheat 76,230 bushels; and Oats 3,729 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE TERMINAL ELEVATORS. (FT. WILLIAM AND FT. ARTHUR). The total grain in store shows a net decrease of 2,468,793 bushels made up as follows:- Wheat 1,345,377 bushels; Oats 742,771 bushels; Barley 195,266 bushels; Flax 31,970 bushels and Rye 153,409 bushels. The total grain in store was 18,804,398 bushels compared with 21,273,191 bushels for the previous week.

WINNIPEG PRIVATE TERMINALS. A net decrease is shown in the total grain in store of 5,867 bushels. Wheat and Oats show decreases of 1,001 and 5,198 bushels respectively while Barley shows an increase of 332 bushels.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST. Canadian Grain. The total grain in store shows a net increase of 190,008 bushels. Wheat and Barley show a decrease of 198,731 and 27,839 bushels respectively, while Oats show an increase of 416,578 bushels.

5,359,888 bushels of grain were received at the above elevators by Vessels of which 4,192,609 bushels was Wheat. The receipts of the above by classes of ports were as follows:-

CANADIAN SEABOARD PORTS (MONTREAL AND QUEBEC). The total grain in store shows a net increase of 1,097,283 bushels. Increases are shown in Wheat of 972,599 bushels and Oats 202,210 bushels while Barley shows a decrease of 76,589 bushels and Rye 937 bushels. The movement overseas was as follows:- Wheat 1,913,495 bushels; Oats 37,647 bushels; Barley 144,498 bushels; a total of 2,095,640 bushels.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST (U.S. GRAIN). 4,085,846 bushels of U.S. grain were in store compared with 4,801,620 bushels for the same week last year a decrease of 715,774 bushels. The quantities in store by classes of ports were as follows:-




