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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING January 2nd, 1925.

Returns received at the Dominion Bureau of Statistics showing stocks of grain in store for the week ending January 2nd 1925, show a net increase of 3,382,387 bushels over the previous week. The stocks for the week were as follows: Wheat 30,592,251 bushels; Oats 30,319,557 bushels; Barley 13,734,957 bushels; Flax 4,309,905 bushels; Rye 4,139,099 bushels, a total of 143,095,769 bushels. Increases are shown in Wheat of 3,130,368 bushels; Oats 204,853 bushels; Flax 6,595 bushels and Rye 11,933 bushels, while Barley shows decrease of 71,417 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS. A net increase is shown in the total grain in store of 10,100 bushels. Increases are shown in Wheat of 308,275 bushels; Oats 256,437 bushels; Barley 56,398 bushels, while Flax and Rye show decreases of 35,809 and 201 bushels.

The following table shows the quantities of grain in store at the Country Elevators in each of the Prairie Provinces on December 26th, 1924, with comparison for the previous week and the same period 1923.


INTERIOR TERMINAL ELEVATORS (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW, CALGARY & EDMONTON). Grain stocks show a net increase of 33,213 bushels over the previous week. Increases are shown in Wheat of 32,820 bushels; Oats 5,058 bushels; Flax 1,393 bushels and Rye 352 bushels, while Barley shows a decrease of 6,410 bushels.

VANCOUVER TERMINAL ELEVATORS. This paragraph was inadvertently left out of last week's press letter. For the present week the grain stocks show a net decrease of 136,719 bushels. Wheat and Oats show decreases of 157,078 bushels and 4,042 bushels respectively. Barley shows an increase of 24,401 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE TERMINAL ELEVATORS (FT. WILLIAM AND PT. ARTHUR). This paragraph was also left out of last week's press letter. The present week, the grain in store shows an increase of 2,059,194 bushels made up as follows: Wheat 1,496,987 bushels; Oats 313,053 bushels; Barley 135,886 bushels; Flax 91,976 bushels and Rye 21,292 bushels.

PRIVATE TERMINAL ELEVATORS (WINNIPEG). A net decrease is shown in the total grain in store of 2,827 bushels. Oats, Barley and Rye show decreases of 7,887, 7,351 and 903 bushels, respectively, while Wheat and Flax show increases of 12,885 and 429 bushels.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST (CANADIAN GRAIN). The total grain in store shows a net increase of 286,848 bushels. Decreases are shown in Oats of 68,029 bushels; Barley 64,648 bushels and Flax 51,394 bushels, while Wheat and Rye show increases of 467,562 and 3,357 bushels, respectively.

239,597 bushels and 591,535 bushels of grain were received at the above elevators by Vessel and Rail respectively, the former from winter storage afloat. Of these amounts 239,597 bushels and 439,436 bushels were Wheat.

The quantity of Canadian grain in store at the St. Lawrence and Seaboard Ports were as follows: Wheat 3,033,218 bushels; Oats 4,565,692 bushels; Barley 707,079 bushels; Flax 32,089 bushels; Rye 134,145 bushels, a total of 8,272,223 bushels.

The overseas shipments from Atlantic Seaboard Ports (West St. John and St. John) were as follows: Wheat 367,958 bushels; Oats 18,988 bushels; Barley 124,899 bushels, a total of 511,845 bushels.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST (U.S. GRAIN). 8,913,439 bushels more U. S. grain were in store at the above elevators than during the same week last year. These increases were shown in the following grains: Wheat 2,277,267 bushels; Oats 1,631,711 bushels; Barley 396,512 bushels; Rye 3,425,792 bushels and Corn 1,182,157 bushels.

U. S. LAKE PORTS. A net increase is shown in the total grain in store of 585,797 bushels. Wheat and Rye show increases of 710,796 and 125,717 bushels, respectively, while Oats and Barley show decreases of 210,189 and 40,524 bushels.

U. S. ATLANTIC SEABOARD PORTS. The total grain in store shows a net decrease of 23,219 bushels. Oats shows a decrease of 79,548 bushels; Barley 169,166 bushels and Rye 32,626 bushels, while an increase took place in Wheat of 258,121 bushels.


