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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING NOVEMBER 13th, 1925

Returns received as to the stocks of grain in store for the week ending November 13th, 1925, show a net increase of 8,631,037 bushels over the previous week. The stocks for the week were as follows: Wheat 86,424,374 bushels; Oats 9,424,229 bushels; Barley 12,922,230 bushels; Flax 2,022,672 bushels; Rye 2,275,357 bushels, a total of 113,742,822 bushels. Increases are shown in Wheat of 7,453,009 bushels; Oats 257,250 bushels; Flax 203,308 bushels; Rye 603,622 bushels, while Barley shows a decrease of 486,152 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS. - An increase is shown in the grain stocks of 3,427,813 bushels made up as follows:- Wheat 2,547,365 bushels; Oats 494,918 bushels; Barley 139,696 bushels; Flax 200,426 bushels and Rye 45,408 bushels.

INTERIOR TERMINAL ELEVATORS (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW, EDMONTON AND CALGARY). - The total grain shows an increase of 589,626 bushels over the previous week made up as follows: Wheat 504,433 bushels; Oats 79,703 bushels; Barley 5,011 bushels; Flax 479 bushels.

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VANCOUVER TERMINAL AND PRIVATE ELEVATORS. - A net increase is shown in the total grain stocks of 818,966 bushels. Increases are shown in Wheat of 821,925 bushels; Barley of 3,094 bushels and Rye of 213 bushels, while a decrease is shown in Oats of 6,271 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE TERMINAL ELEVATORS (FT. WILLIAM AND FORT ARTHUR). - The grain stocks at the Head of the Lakes show a net increase of 2,453,175 bushels. Increases are shown in Wheat of 2,086,804 bushels; Oats of 98,645 bushels; Barley of 287,303 bushels; Flax of 21,783 bushels, while Rye shows a decrease of 41,360 bushels.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST (U.S.GRAIN). - There were 4,376,081 bushels less United States grain in store than for the same week of last year. Decreases are shown in Wheat of 865,952 bushels; Rye 3,062,306 bushels; Corn 1,030,928 bushels, while Oats and Barley show increases of 319,812 and 263,287 bushels respectively.

U.S. LAKE PORTS (DULUTH AND BUFFALO). - A net decrease is shown in the total grain stocks of 1,920,078 bushels. Decreases are shown in Wheat of 1,780,827 bushels and Barley of 226,678 bushels, while Oats and Flax show increases of 84,193 and 3,234 bushels, respectively.

U. S. ATLANTIC SEABOARD PORTS. - Grain stock also show a net decrease of 222,102 bushels. Decreases are shown in Barley of 222,534 bushels and of Rye 44,792 bushels, while increases are shown in Wheat of 11,079 and of Oats 74,145 bushels.

DULUTH. - During the week ended November 14th, 1925, the receipts of Canadian bonded grain by rail were as follows: Wheat 40,984 bushels; Oats 10,647 bushels; Barley 32,797 bushels and Flax 3,234 bushels, a total of 93,662 bushels. The water shipments were Barley 55,000 bushels.


