CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING APRIL 16th, 1926

Returns received as to the stocks of grain in store for the week ending April 16th 1926, show a net decrease of 2,750,669 bushels from the previous week. The stocks for the week were as follows:- Wheat 98,282,810 bushels; Oats 20,357,556 bushels; Barley 14,273,668 bushels; Flax 3,591,040 bushels; and Rye 3,290,607 bushels; a total of 139,795,681 bushels. Decreases are shown in Wheat of 1,699,132 bushels; Oats 573,219 bushels; Barley 621,466 bushels and Flax 3,228 bushels while Rye shows an increase of 146,376 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS. - Grain stocks show a net decrease of 410,046 bushels. Decreases are shown in Wheat of 357,706 bushels; Oats 129,737 bushels and Flax 6,859 bushels while increases are shown in Barley of 83,459 bushels and Rye 797 bushels.



INTERIOR TERMINAL ELEVATORS (SASKATOON, CALGARY, MOOSE JAW, EDMONTON AND WINNIPEG). A net decrease is shown in the total grain stocks of 393,291 bushels. Decreases are shown in Wheat of 386,020 bushels and Barley 27,261 bushels while increases are shown in Oats of 19,930 bushels; Flax 13 bushels and Rye 47 bushels.

VANCOUVER TERMINAL PRIVATE ELEVATORS. - A net decrease is shown in the total grain stocks of 308,268 bushels. Decreases are shown in Wheat of 312,072 bushels; Barley 612 bushels; Flax 14 bushels; Rye 2,148 bushels while Oats show an increase of 6,578 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE TERMINAL ELEVATORS (FT. WILLIAM AND PT. ARTHUR). - An increase is shown in the total grain stocks at the Head of the Lakes of 561,808 bushels made up as follows:- Wheat 510,798 bushels; Oats 8,073 bushels; Barley 31,145 bushels; Flax 7,571 bushels and Rye 4,221 bushels.


