CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING JANUARY 14th, 1927.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending January 14, 1927, show a net increase of 6,561,094 bushels from the previous week. Stocks for the week were as follows:- Wheat 135,988,894; Oats 15,183,268; Barley 13,599,096; Flax 3,785,318; Rye 5,111,730; a total of 173,668,306 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 6,557,862 and Flax 310,450 bushels, while Oats show a decrease of 95,094; Barley 115,032 and Rye 97,092 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks show a net decrease of 1,093,576 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 914,806; Barley 192,850 and Flax 70,361, while Oats and Rye show increases of 67,007 and 17,434 bushels respectively.

INTERIOR TERMINAL ELEVATORS(SASKATOON, MOOSE JAV, EDMONTON AND CALGARY).- A net decrease is shown in the grain stocks of 40,912 bushels. Wheat shows a decrease of 49,311, while an increase is noted in Oats of 8,207; Barley 72 and Flax 120 bushels.

VANCOUVER AND PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATORS.- A net decrease of 190,166 bushels is shown in the grain stocks. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 198,052 and Flax 1 bushel, while Oats and Barley show increase of 4,345 and 3,542 bushels respectively.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE TERMINAL ELEVATORS (FT. WILLIAM AND PT. ARTHUR).- A net increase is shown in the grain stocks of 3,482,129 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 3,898,523; Oats 3,967; Flax 39,256 and Rye 98,393 bushels, while Barley shows a decrease of 558,010 bushels.


