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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING APRIL 29th, 1927

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending April 29th, 1927, show a net decrease of 4,858,038 bushels. Stocks were as follows:- Wheat 80,845,237; Oats 11,315,102; Barley 8,974,183; Flax 3,037,915; Rye 3,183,361, a total of 107,355,793 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 4,436,523; Oats 691,593; Flax 170,832 and Rye 284,500, while Barley shows an increase of 725,410 bushels.

Western Country Elevators:- A decrease of 3,704,955 bushels is noted in the grain stocks made up as follows:- Wheat 2,951,402; Oats 422,583; Barley 184,034; Flax 65,672 and Rye 81,259 bushels.

The following table shows the quantities of grain in store at the Country elevators in each of the Prairie Provinces on April 22nd, 1927, with comparison for the previous week and the same period 1926.

INTERIOR TERMINAL ELEVATORS (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW, EDMONTON AND CALGARY). A net decrease is shown in the grain stocks of 609,851 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 572,298; Oats 31,477; Barley 8,101 and Rye 1,608, while Flax shows an increase of 3,633 bushels.

VANCOUVER PRIVATE AND TERMINAL ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks at these ports show a decrease of 375,605 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 369,733, Oats 4,327 and Barley 1,545 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT PRIVATE ELEVATORS.- Wheat stocks at these elevators show a decrease of 10,385 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE TERMINAL ELEVATORS (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR). Stocks at the Head of the Lakes show a net decrease of 5,371,260 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 4,475,675; Barley 949,452; Flax 133,782 and Rye 182,695, while Oats show an increase of 370,344 bushels.




