

CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING AUGUST 5th, 1927.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending August 5th show a decrease of 4,368,065 bushels. Stocks were as follows:- Wheat 40,222,122; Oats 4,083,267; Barley 2,126,940; Flax 1,838,864; Rye 1,079,121, a total of 49,350,314 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 2,449,361; Oats 837,277; Barley 725,689; Flax 213,457 and Rye 142,281 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS.- Stocks of grain at these elevators show a decrease of 1,866,452 bushels, made up as follows:- Wheat 1,123,704; Oats 385,609; Barley 243,204; Flax 54,212 and Rye 59,723 bushels.


