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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING AUGUST 5th, 1927.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending August 12th, 1927, show a decrease of 4,035,860 bushels. Stocks were as follows:- Wheat 37,130,019; Oats 3,650,865; Barley 1,746,085; Flax 1,324,631 and Rye 962,854, a total of 45,314,454 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat 3,092,103; Oats 432,402; Barley 380,855; Flax 14,233 and Rye 116,267 bushels.

Western Country Elevators.- Stocks of grain at these elevators show an increase of 6,019 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat 4,223; Barley 3,003, and Rye 2,958, while Oats and Flax show an increase of 14,419 and 1,784 bushels respectively.

The following table shows the quantities of grain in store at the Country Elevators in each of the Prairie Provinces on August 5th, 1927, with comparison for the previous week and the same period 1926.

INTERIOR TERMINAL ELEVATORS (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW, EDMONTON AND CALGARY).- A decrease is noted in the grain stocks of 92,620 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat 67,191; Oats 21,091, and Rye 4,672 while Barley and Flax show increases of 326 and 8 bushels respectively.

VANCOUVER PRIVATE AND TERMINAL ELEVATORS.- Wheat stocks at these elevators show a decrease of 93,998 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATORS.- Stocks at this elevator are the same as for previous week.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE TERMINAL ELEVATORS (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR).- Stocks at the Head of the lakes show a decrease of 3,203, 144 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat 2,553,422; Oats 273,881; Barley 260,517 and Rye 122,445 while Flax shows an increase of 7,121 bushels.




