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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING DECEMBER 30th, 1927

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for week ending December 30th, 1927, show a net increase of 4,132,118 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows: Wheat 159,357,557, Oats 11,044,124, Barley 10,030,208, Flax 3,173,839, and Rye 4,104,772 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat 4,086,782, Oats 144,210, and Flax 196,688, while Barley and Rye show decreases of 168,558 and 127,004 bushels respectively.

WESTERN COUNTY ELEVATORS. - Stocks of grain at these elevators show a net decrease of 445,670 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat 532,527, Barley 69,546, Flax 22,670, and Rye 9,703, while Oats shows an increase of 188,776 bushels.

The following table shows the quantities of grain in store at the Country Elevators in each of the Prairie Provinces on December 23rd, 1927, with comparison for the previous week and the same period 1926.

INTERIOR TERMINAL ELEVATORS (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW, EDMONTON AND CALGARY). - Stocks for the week show a net decrease of 202,021 bushels. Wheat shows a decrease of 211,410, while Oats and Barley show increases of 7,599, and 1,790 bushels respectively.

VANCOUVER PRIVATE AND TERMINAL ELEVATORS. - Grain stocks at these elevators show a net increase of 258,790 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat 266,033 and Rye 4,609, while Oats and Barley show decreases of 11,376 and 476 bushels respectively.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATORS. - Grain stocks at this elevator show a net decrease of 152,809 bushels. Wheat shows a decrease of 153,180, while Oats shows an increase of 371 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ELEVATORS (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR). - Stocks at the Head of the Lakes show an increase of 6,499,549 bushels and made up as follows, Wheat 5,887,441, Oats 17,035, Barley 321,350, Flax 75,290 and Rye 198,433 bushels.


PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST - LAKE PORTS(CANADIAN GRAIN). - Grain stocks for the week show a decrease of 1,683,339 bush. made up as follows: Wheat 1,562,839, Oats 20,000 and Rye 100,500 bush.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST - SEABOARD PORTS(CANADIAN GRAIN). - Grain stocks show a net decrease of 166,063 bush. Decreases are noted in Oats 78,506, Barley 30,382, Flax 16,677 and Rye 113,796 bush., while Wheat shows an increase of 73,298 bush.

Increases are noted in Wheat of 265,019; Oats 12,355; Flax 2,726 and Rye 53, while Barley shows a decrease of 82,541 bushels.






