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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING JANUARY 27th, 1928

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending Jan. 27, 1928 show a net increase of 7,401,764 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows: Wheat 167,212,211, Oats 11,506,417, Barley 10,389,947, Flax 3,076,280 and Rye 4,836,117, a total of 197,020,972 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat 6,643,004, Oats 225,919, Barley 470,121 and Rye 70,070 bushels, while Flax shows a decrease of 7,350 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS.- Stocks of grain at these elevators show a net decrease of 1,678,410 bush. Decreases are noted in Wheat 1,542,302, Barley 131,222, Flax 22,603 and Rye 23,176 bush, while Oats show an increase of 40,893 bushels.






