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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING MAY 18th, 1928

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending May 18th, 1928 show a net decrease of 4,759,948 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows: Wheat 115,405,823, Oats 9,043,666, Barley 6,938,010, Flax 2,353,361 and Rye 3,094,176, a total of 136,835,536 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 1,912,617, Oats 1,312,944, Barley 1,037,684 and Rye 489,012 bushels, while Flax shows an increase of 24,623 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:-

Stocks of grain in store in these elevators show a decrease of 5,868,147 bushels made up as follows:- Wheat 3,484,393, Oats 1,739,769, Barley 396,619, Flax 43,569 and Rye 203,797 bushels.



INTERIOR TERMINAL (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW, EDMONTON AND CALGARY).- Stocks for the week show a net decrease of 240,761 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 130,929, Oats 79,113, Barley 26,826 and Rye 5,211 bushels while Flax shows an increase of 1,318 bushels.

VANCOUVER PRIVATE AND TERMINAL ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks at these elevators show decrease of 230,041 bushels, made up as follows:- Wheat 228,773, Oats 960 and Barley 308 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATORS.- Wheat stocks for the week show an increase of 21,732 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ELEVATORS (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR).- Stocks at the Head of the Lakes show a net decrease of 3,598,029 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 2,503,998, Barley 731,070, Flax 13,247 and Rye 454,722 bushels while Oats show an increase of 105,008 bushels.

INTERIOR PRIVATE AND MANUFACTURING ELEVATORS:- A net decrease is noted in the grain stocks of 2,258 bushels. Decreases are noted in Oats of 120,861, Barley 104,462, and Rye 4,323 bushels while Wheat and Flax show increases of 215,588 and 11,800 bushels respectively.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST - LAKE PORTS (CANADIAN GRAIN).- Grain stocks for the week show a net increase of 1,122,564 bushels. Increases are noted in wheat 1,276,826, Oats 207,261, and Flax 37,306 bushels while Barley and Rye show decreases of 334,143 and 64,686 bushels respectively.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST - SEABOARD PORTS (CANADIAN GRAIN).- Grain stocks show a net increase of 1,712,385 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 1,335,436, Oats 239,489, Flax 31,015 and Rye 194,795 bushels while Barley shows a decrease of 83,350 bushels.

U.S. LAKE PORTS. - Canadian grain stocks show an increase of 1,994,535 bushels made up as follows: Wheat 1,464,124, Oats 80,000 and Barley 450,411 bushels.

U.S. ATLANTIC SEABOARD PORTS. - Stocks of Canadian grain show a net increase of 360,386 bushels. Increases are shown in Wheat of 121,770, Barley 193,683, Rye 48,932 bushels, while Oats shows a decrease of 3,999 bushels.

DULUTH. - Receipts by rail of Canadian bonded grain at Duluth for the week ending May 19, 1928, amounted to Barley 4,559 bushels. Shipments by lake amounted to 108,000 bushels Wheat.


