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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING JUNE 15th, 1928

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending June 15th show a net decrease of 5,024,530 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows:- Wheat 103,620,473, Oats 9,112,047, Barley 3,864,882, Flax 1,883,910, Rye 2,350,021, a total of 120,831,333 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 4,634,469, Barley 809,464 and Flax 128,860 bushels, while Oats and Rye show increases of 388,608 and 159,655 bushels respectively.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS.- Stocks of grain in store in these elevators show a decrease of 2,174,186 bushels made up as follows:- Wheat 1,817,772, Oats 196,650, Barley 86,064, Flax 25,441 and Rye 48,259 bushels.

INTERIOR TERMINAL (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW, EDMONTON AND CALGARY):- Stocks for the week show a net decrease of 1,846 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 24,522 and Barley 5,679 while Oats and Flax show increases of 27,056 and 1,299 bushels respectively.

VANCOUVER PRIVATE AND TERMINAL ELEVATORS:- Grain stocks at these elevators show a net increase of 223,981 bushels. Wheat and Oats show increases of 223,563 and 817 bushels while Barley shows a decrease of 399 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATORS:- Wheat stocks for the week show an increase of 18,626 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ELEVATORS (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR):- Stocks at the Head of the Lake show a net decrease of 838,728 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 33,442, Oats 392,895, Barley 332,893 and Flax 125,285 bushels, while Rye shows an increase of 46,787 bushels.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST - LAKE PORTS (CANADIAN GRAIN).- Grain stocks for the week show a net increase of 796,645 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 169,393, Oats 397,306, Flax 26,853 and Rye 2,837, while Barley shows a decrease of 99,744 bushels.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST - SEABOARD PORTS (CANADIAN GRAIN).- Grain stocks show a net decrease of 731,861 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 716,814 and Barley 232,738, while Oats and Rye show increases of 87,776 and 129,915 bushels respectively.

U.S. LAKE PORTS.- Canadian grain stocks show a net decrease of 1,514,449 bushels wheat shows a decrease of 1,867,886 bushels, while Oats and Barley show decreases of 167,667 and 185,770 bushels respectively.

U.S. ATLANTIC SEABOARD PORTS.- Stocks of Canadian grain show a net decrease of 164,-420 bushels. Decreases are noted in wheat of 39,624 and in Barley of 169,269 bushels, while Oats and Rye show increases of 17,956 and 26,517 bushels respectively.

Duluth.- There were no receipts and shipments of Canadian bonded grain at Duluth for the week ending June 16th, 1928.




