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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING OCTOBER 5, 1928

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending October 5, show an increase of 32,916,808 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows:- Wheat 103,210,117; Oats 4,322,233; Barley 12,123,060; Flax 445,729 and Rye 4,034,663 a total of 124,135,802 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 27,548,498; Oats 977,031; Barley 2,788,221; Flax 8,064 and Rye 1,594,994 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS. - Stocks of grain at these elevators show an increase of 18,611,634 made up as follows:- Wheat 17,208,855, Oats 625,109, Barley 682,496, Flax 70,058 and Rye 25,116 bushels.

INTERIOR TERMINAL (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW, EDMONTON AND CALGARY). - Stocks for the week show an increase of 249,079 bushels, made up as follows: Wheat 227,525, Oats 7,096, Barley 7,582 and Rye 6,876 bushels.

VANCOUVER PRIVATE AND TERMINAL ELEVATORS. - Grain stocks at these elevators show a net increase of 1,524,577 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 1,518,832 and Oats 10,594 bushels, while Barley and Rye show decreases of 764 and 4,085 bushels respectively.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATORS. - Wheat stocks at this elevator show an increase of 993 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ELEVATORS (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR). - Stocks at the Head of the Lakes show a net increase of 3,292,454 bush. Increases are noted in Wheat of 5,342,200 Oats 175,512, Barley 939,513 and Rye 1,378,839 bush, while Flax shows a decrease of 43,615 bushels.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST (CANADIAN GRAIN):- Grain stocks for the week show a net increase of 2,118,241 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 1,256,994, Barley 705,070 and Rye 193,861 bushels, while Oats and Flax show decreases of 25,555 and 12,129 bushels respectively.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST SEABOARD (CANADIAN GRAIN):- Grain stocks show a net increase of 631,629 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 523,318 and Barley 119,423, while Flax and Rye show decreases of 3,612 and 7,500 bushels respectively.

EXPORTS OF GRAIN BY CANADIAN INLAND PORTS OF EXIT


