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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING OCTOBER 19th, 1928.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending October 19, 1928, show an increase of 16,727,924 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows: Wheat, 1,47,205,137, Oats, 7,360,740, Barley, 15,872,853, Flax, 1,041,975 and Rye, 3,199,946 bushels. Increases were noted in Wheat, 13,508,941, Oats, 1,248,724, Barley, 1,598,197, Flax, 274,757 and Rye, 97,755 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Stocks of grain at these elevators show an increase of 2,468,971 bushels made up as follows: Wheat, 1,092,767, Oats, 920,451, Barley, 176,298, Flax, 216,359 and Rye, 52,596 bushels.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST (CANADIAN GRAIN). - Grain stocks for the week show a net increase of 970,209 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat, 1,127,764, Oats 8,369 and Flax 49,242 bushels, while Barley and Rye show decreases of 166,919 and 48,247 bushels respectively.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST SEABOARD (CANADIAN GRAIN). - Grain stocks show a net decrease of 31,746 bushels. Decreases are noted in Oats and Barley of 52,609 and 144,948 bushels respectively, while Wheat and Rye show increases of 162,638 and 3,173 bushels respectively.




