CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING AUGUST 10th, 1928.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending August 10th, 1928, show a net decrease of 11,145,086 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows: Wheat 56,722,160, Oats 4,538,985, Barley 1,696,725, Flax 1,221,700 and Rye 981,254, a total of 65,160,824 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 9,332,525, Oats 1,009,633, Barley 563,701 and Rye 262,279, while Flax shows an increase of 28,052 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS:- Grain stocks at these elevators show a decrease of 728,957 bushels, made up as follows: Wheat 495,838, Oats 120,094, Barley 53,220, Flax 16,147 and Rye 43,558 bushels.

The following table shows the quantities of grain in store at the Country Elevators in each of the Prairie Provinces on August 3rd, 1928, with comparison for the previous week and the same period 1927.

INTERIOR TERMINAL (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW, EDMONTON AND CALGARY):- Stocks for the week show a decrease of 757,442 bushels, made up as follows: Wheat 722,737, Oats 29,838 and Flax 4,867 bushels.

VANCOUVER PRIVATE AND TERMINAL ELEVATORS:- Grain stocks at these elevators show a net decrease of 13,615 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 3,641 and Oats 10,332 bushels, while Barley shows an increase of 358 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATOR:- Wheat stocks at this elevator are the same as for previous week.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ELEVATORS (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR):- Stocks at the Head of the Lakes show a decrease of 8,153,045, made up as follows: Wheat 6,981,797, Oats 812,087, Barley 157,718, Flax 21,183 and Rye 160,260 bushels.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST - LAKE PORTS (CANADIAN GRAIN). Grain stocks for the week show a net increase of 484,194 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 107,696; Oats 316,756 and Rye 79,199 bushels, while Barley shows a decrease of 19,457 bushels.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST - SEABOARD PORTS (CANADIAN GRAIN).- Grain stocks show a net decrease of 1,190,720 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 892,956; Oats 321,704 and Rye 121,853 bushels, while Barley and Flax show increases of 66,824 and 78,969 bushels, respectively.






