CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING DECEMBER 21st, 1928

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending December 21st, 1928 show a net increase of 7,620,559 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows:- Wheat 225,329,818, Oats 20,221,680, Barley 22,758,444, Flax 1,868,168 and Rye 4,800,251, a total of 274,978,361 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 3,814,568, Oats 2,057,670, Barley 2,624,403 and Flax 103,265 while Rye shows a decrease of 979,347 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS.- Stocks of grain at these elevators show a net decrease of 7,981,868 bushels. Wheat and Flax show decreases of 8,518,712 and 24,107 bushels respectively while increases are noted in Oats of 534,212, Barley 10,466 and Rye 16,273 bushels.

The following table shows the quantities of grain in store at the Country Elevators in each of the Prairie Provinces on December 7th, 1928, with comparison for the previous week and the same period, 1927.

INTERIOR TERMINAL (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW, EDMONTON AND CALGARY).- Stocks for the week show a net decrease of 35,483 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 25,554 bushels Oats 137, Barley 1,404 and Rye 3,570 bushels, while Flax shows a decrease of 182 bushels.

VANCOUVER PRIVATE AND TERMINAL ELEVATORS.- Grain stocks at these elevators show a net increase of 412,920 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 395,099, Oats 6,610 and Barley 11,111 bushels.

VICTORIA ELEVATORS.- Stocks at this elevator show an increase of 15,984 bushels made up as follows: Wheat 4,634 and Barley 11,350 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATORS.- Stocks at this elevator show an increase of 113,873 bushels made up as follows:- Wheat 113,746 and Oats 127 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR).- Stocks at the Head of the Lakes show an increase of 13,658,522 bushels made up as follows:- Wheat 12,043,200, Oats 695,023, Barley 554,321, Flax 103,690 and Rye 162,288 bushels.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST - LAKE PORTS (CANADIAN GRAIN).- Grain stocks for the week show a net increase of 1,696,631 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 835,591, Oats 742,209, Flax 60,202 and Rye 150,404, while Barley shows a decrease of 91,475 bushels.




