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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING AUGUST 17, 1928.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending August 17th, 1928, show a net decrease of 12,412,795 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows: Wheat 45,529,190, Oats 4,273,104, Barley 1,184,002, Flax 1,237,279 and Rye 524,454, a total of 52,748,029 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 11,192,970, Oats 265,381, Barley 512,723 and Rye 456,800 bushels, while Flax shows an increase of 15,579 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS. Grain stocks at these elevators show a net decrease of 98,897 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 48,413, Oats 49,838, Barley 202 and Flax 1,846 bushels, while Rye shows an increase of 1,402 bushels.

The following table shows the quantities of grain in store at the Country Elevators in each of the Prairie Provinces on August 10th, 1928, with comparison for the previous week and the same period 1927.

INTERIOR TERMINAL (SASKATOON, MOOSEJAW, EDMONTON AND CALGARY):- Stocks for the week show a decrease of 987,988 bushels, made up as follows:- Wheat 973,996, Oats 7,033, Barley 304 and Flax 6,155 bushels.

VANCOUVER PRIVATE AND TERMINAL ELEVATORS:- Grain stocks at these elevators show a net decrease of 465,470 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 472,898 and Rye 1,248 bushels, while Oats and Barley show increases of 3,860 and 4,816 bushels, respectively.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATOR:- Wheat stocks at this elevator are the same as for previous week.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ELEVATORS (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR):- Stocks at the Head of the Lakes show a net decrease of 5,450,558 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 5,009,926, Oats 233,655, Barley 60,207 and Rye 156,062, while Flax shows an increase of 9,292 bushels.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST - LAKE PORTS (CANADIAN GRAIN):- Grain stocks for the week show a net increase of 645,384 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 581,314, Oats 325,423 and Flax 17,621 bushels, while Barley and Rye show decreases of 59 and 278,915 bushels respectively.

PUBLIC ELEVATORS IN THE EAST - SEABOARD PORTS (CANADIAN GRAIN):- Grain stocks show a net decrease of 446,065 bushels. Decreases are noted in Oats of 312,754, Barley 187,819 and Rye 67,710 bushels, while Wheat shows an increase of 122,218 bushels.



SIGHTING OF WHALE SPECIES





CHART OF THE SOUTHERN OCEAN - INDICATING POSITION AND DATES OF
