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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING FEBRUARY 22, 1929.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending February 22, show a net decrease of 2,747,386 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows: Wheat 201,234,639, Oats 22,358,353, Barley 20,773,235, Flax 1,646,257 and Rye 4,832,638, a total of 250,845,122 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 3,177,951, Barley 237,017 and Flax 38,246 bushels, while Oats and Rye show increases of 580,683 and 125,145 bushels, respectively.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS. - Stocks of grain at these elevators show a net increase of 1,352,734 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 496,730, Oats 664,777, Barley 212,730 and Rye 12,176, while Flax shows a decrease of 33,679 bushels.

The following table shows the quantities of grain in store at the Country Elevators in each of the Prairie Provinces on February 15th, 1929, with comparison for the previous week and the same period 1928.

INTERIOR TERMINAL (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW, EDMONTON AND CALGARY). - Stocks for the week show a net decrease of 623,625 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 646,646 and Barley 1,429, while Oats and Flax show increases of 19,617 and 4,833 bushels, respectively.

VANCOUVER PRIVATE AND TERMINAL ELEVATORS. - Grain stocks at these elevators show a net increase of 319,222 bushels. Wheat and Oats show increases of 350,609 and 12,007 bush., respectively, while Barley shows a decrease of 43,394 bushels.

VICTORIA ELEVATOR. - Wheat stocks at this elevator are the same as for the previous week.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATOR. - Wheat stocks at this elevator show an increase of 49,574 bushels.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR). - Stocks at the Head of the Lakes show a net increase of 601,923 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 598,226, Barley 85,443 and Rye 33,862, while Oats and Flax show decreases of 108,600 and 7,008 bushels, respectively.

DULUTH.- The receipts by rail of Canadian bonded grain at Duluth for the week ending February 23, 1929, were Wheat 4,676 and Barley 5,481 bushels. Lake shipments were nil. Rail shipments amounted to Wheat 8,978 bushels. For the period from August 1, 1928, to February 23, 1929, the rail receipts amounted to Wheat 707,494, Oats 14,452, Barley 541,690, Flax 2,838 and Rye 15,015 bushels. Lake shipments were as follows:- Wheat 493,743 and Barley 469,900 bushels. Shipments by rail were Wheat 24,908, Flax 3,906 and Rye 2,267 bushels.



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


