CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING APRIL 19, 1929.

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending April 19, 1929, show a decrease of 13,149,794 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows:- Wheat 174,623,898, Oats 24,302,256, Barley 19,378,525, Flax 1,297,179 and Rye 4,370,065, a total of 223,971,923 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 11,247,499, Oats 642,769, Barley 1,033,243, Flax 3,833 and Rye 222,451 bushels.

WESTERN COUNTRY ELEVATORS: Stocks in store at these elevators show a decrease of 1,914,405 bushels made up as follows:- Wheat 1,617,840, Oats 167,581, Barley 48,625, Flax 25,634 and Rye 54,725 bushels.

The following table shows the quantities of grain in store at the Country Elevators in each of the Prairie Provinces on April 12th, 1929, with comparison for the previous week and the same period 1928.

INTERIOR TERMINAL (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW, EDMONTON AND CALGARY): Stocks for the week show a net decrease of 130,337 bushels. Wheat and Oats show decreases of 115,349 and 24,284 bushels respectively, while Barley and Flax show increases of 401 and 8,895 bushels respectively.

VANCOUVER PRIVATE AND TERMINAL ELEVATORS: Grain stocks at these elevators show a net increase of 245,312 bushels. Wheat shows an increase of 296,004, while decreases are noted in Oats of 4,382, Barley 46,163 and Rye 147 bushels.

VICTORIA ELEVATOR: Stocks at this elevator are the same as for the previous week.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATOR: Stocks at this elevator are the same as for the previous week.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR): Stocks at the Head of the Lakes show a net decrease of 8,005,161 bushels. Decreases are noted in Wheat of 7,557,971, Oats 13,549, Barley 332,959 and Rye 102,238, while Flax shows an increase of 1,556 bushels.
