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CANADIAN GRAIN STATISTICS - WEEK ENDING SEPTEMBER 21, 1928

Returns received as to stocks of grain in store for the week ending September 21 show a net increase of 18,363,397 bushels. Stocks for the week were as follows: Wheat 45,586,224; Oats 2,798,258; Barley 7,094,788; Flax 534,405 and Rye 2,252,575; a total of 58,266,250 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 14,576,534 and Barley 3,165,002 and Rye 674,470 bushels, while Oats and Flax show decreases of 29,794 and 22,815 bushels respectively.

Western Country Elevators. Stocks of grain at these elevators show an increase of 12,649,542 bushels made up as follows: Wheat 11,143,083; Oats 240,958; Barley 1,005,233; Flax 9,192 and Rye 251,076 bushels.

INTERIOR TERMINAL (SASKATOON, MOOSE JAW, EDMONTON AND CALGARY). - Stocks for the week show a net increase of 36,025 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 36,799; Oats 569; Barley 1,421 and Rye 616 bushels, while Flax shows a decrease of 3,380 bushels.

VANCOUVER PRIVATE AND TERMINAL ELEVATORS. - Grain stocks at these elevators show a net increase of 117,620 bushels. Increases are noted in Oats of 110,537; barley 1,217 and Rye 8,654 bushels while Wheat shows a decrease of 2,785 bushels.

PRINCE RUPERT ELEVATORS. - Wheat stocks at this elevator are the same as for the previous week.

PUBLIC AND PRIVATE ELEVATORS (FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR). - Stocks at the Head of the Lakes show a net increase of 7,091,226 bushels. Increases are noted in Wheat of 4,939,998; Oats 31,824; Barley 1,741,460 and Rye 419,408 bushels while Flax shows a decrease of 41,464 bushels.


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
