ASBECTOS PRODUCTION IN CANADA, NOVAMBER, 1933.
Canadian producers shipped 20,463 tons of asbestos in November; during the preceaing month 19,584 tons were shipped and in November, 1932, the total was 11,616 tons, according to a statement issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Shipments during the first eleven nanths of 1933 totailed 138,107 tons, an advance of 27.4 per cent over the tonnage shippod in the corresponding months of 1932.

During November Canadian asbestos exports wore rucorded at 16,985 tons as compared with 19,329 tons in Octobur; 65.5 per cent of the November exports were consignod to tho Unitud States

Asbustos products imported into Canada in November were valued at $\$ 40,340$; the preceding month's imports wers worth $\$ 37,553$. Importations of asbestos brake and clutch lininc advanced slightly in November to a value of $\$ 10,123$ from the Octobar total of $\{1,011$. Asbestos packine imports amounted to 25,982 pounds worth $\$ 6,632$ as agains $\ddagger 11,931$ pounds at $\$ 3,422$ imported in october. Other asbostos manufactures to a value of $\$ 23,585$ were brought into Canada in Novembor; the United States supplied 50.0 per cent of these fmports, Great Britain, 44.6 per cont, Austria: 5.0 per cent, and Belgium, the remainder.
